Description: This amendment would allow three City departments to spend sub-awards from a grant totaling \$2,773,693 from the United States Department of Justice, National Institute of Justice, Comprehensive School Safety Initiative for the implementation and rigorous impact evaluation of the Rainier Beach Campus Safety Continuum, designed to reduce disparity in school discipline and youth contact with the criminal justice system. This project will be implemented in seven Seattle Public Schools and in community settings in Rainier Beach. This project is a collaboration among the City of Seattle, the Seattle Public Schools, the Seattle Police Department, and nonprofit and community partners serving Seattle’s Rainier Beach

neighborhood. A rigorous evaluation of the Rainier Beach Campus Safety Continuum will be performed by George Mason University. The primary City of Seattle sub-awardee is the Office of City Auditor (OCA). OCA will develop Memoranda of Understanding with SEAIT and SPD for the scope of work associated with their subawards.
