1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE relating to the City Light Department; authorizing the General Manager and Chief Executive Officer to enter into an easement area amendment agreement with King County to revise the legal description of an existing easement for an electric transmission and distribution line through King County Airport property.

Summary and background of the Legislation: The legislation authorizes the General Manager and Chief Executive Officer of the City Light Department, or her designee, to accept a modification of an existing easement granted by King County in 1958.

The City Light Department obtained an easement in 1958 to construct electric distribution poles in an area described in Attachment 1 - Exhibit B of the Ordinance. However, some poles were constructed outside the easement area and this amendment corrects the easement area to encompass those poles, and to release the area that City Light no longer needs.
