1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: A RESOLUTION calling for a special election to fill a vacancy in the City employee-elected position on the Civil Service Commission and directing the City Clerk to administer the election.

Summary and background of the Legislation: The Civil Service Commission consists of three members, including one member appointed by the Mayor, one member appointed by the Council and one member elected by eligible City employees. Vacancies in the employee-elected position must be filled by a special election called by the City Council pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.04.250.
