10	integral to the City's economic health, environmental quality, and social and community
11	fabric; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2009, the Seattle City Council passed Resolution 31157 approving the Seattle
13	Pedestrian Master Plan, which establishes the intent to make Seattle the most
14	walkable city in the nation by addressing safety, equity, vibrancy, and health; and
15	WHEREAS, Objective Five of the Seattle Pedestrian Master Plan calls for creating vibrant
16	public spaces that encourage walking for multiple purposes including transportation,
17	recreation, and health; and
18	WHEREAS, Strategy 5.2 of the Seattle Pedestrian Master Plan recommends developing
19	guidelines and protocols for car-free and shared-space streets, including designating
20	pedestrian-only streets in order to reclaim and activate public spaces for pedestrian use;

22	WHEREAS, pedestrian-oriented spaces such as play streets are a foundational element of
23	transportation-oriented communities, as defined by the Seattle Planning Commission in

1	WHEREAS, Seattle Municipal Code subsection 11.16.125A authorizes the Director of
2	Transportation to close, or authorize closure of, any street or alley or portion thereof to
3	any or all traffic pursuant to the provisions of Seattle Municipal Code Title 11, Subtitle I
4	WHEREAS, the Seattle Department of Transportation has managed a pilot play streets program
5	since May 2014 with 260 applicants having participated in the program to date; and
6	WHEREAS, the Seattle Department of Transportation has prepared technical guidance
7	documents and regulations in advance of a permanent play streets program; NOW,
8	THEREFORE,
9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
10	Section 1. Section 11.40.250 of the Seattle Municipal Code, enacted by Ordinance
11	108200, is amended as follows:
12	11.40.250 Playing in streets((-))
13	No person ((upon)) on roller skates, or riding ((in or by means of any)) a coaster,
14	skateboard, toy vehicle, or similar device, shall go ((upon)) on the roadway of any arterial street
15	or transit coach route, except while crossing ((such)) the street at a crosswalk; or engage in any
16	sport, amusement, or exercise or play in the roadway of any street, except where allowed by a
17	street use permit.
18	Section 2. The Director of Transportation may promulgate rules to administer the Play

Streets program, as authorized in Section 3.12.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code.
