Subject: Small Business Advisory Council Introduction

Mayor Durkan created the **Small Business Advisory Council** by Executive Order 2017-15 in November of 2017. The Advisory Council is made up of 26 Seattle business owner representatives of diverse neighborhoods and small business sectors, with an eye towards equity in race, gender, and LGBTQ inclusion. The Advisory Council meets on a quarterly basis, with additional meetings as needed. SBAC includes two ex-officio City Councilmembers, Councilmember Lisa Herbold and Councilmember Theresa Mosqueda, with Councilmember Deborah Juarez acting as an alternate. Council members are appointed by City Council President Bruce Harrell. OED in conjunction with the Mayor's Office staff the Advisory Council.

The Advisory Council's Co-Chairs will provide an introduction to the Mayor's Small Business Advisory Council's (SBAC) mission and work plan. The four SBAC Co-Chairs are:
