COUNCIL BILL 120201

AN ORDINANCE relating to City funds; closing certain funds, subfunds, and accounts; authorizing the Department of Finance and Administrative Services to take action pursuant to those closures; authorizing the transfer of all unexpended and unencumbered balances and other assets and liabilities of those funds, subfunds, and accounts; and abandoning appropriation authority from those funds, subfunds, and accounts.

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2018, the City Treasury’s Fund structure was re-organized through Ordinance 125492 in keeping with Resolution 31332 and the goals of the implementation of the PeopleSoft 9.2 enterprise financial management system, including the elimination of subfunds within Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Special Employment Fund (00515) was created in 1985 through Ordinance 112556, and was subsequently re-designated as the Special Employment Subfund of the General Fund (00100) in 1995 through Ordinance 117977; and

WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Special Employment Subfund of the General Fund were transferred to a new Special Employment Account in the General Fund through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Cable Television Franchise Subfund (00160) of the General Fund (00100) was created in 1996 through Ordinance 118196; and

WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Cable Television Franchise Subfund of the General Fund were transferred to a new Cable Television Franchise Fund (10101) created through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

1 WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Matching Fund (00165) was created in 1990 through Ordinance
2 115345, and was subsequently re-designated as the Neighborhood Matching Subfund of
3 the General Fund (00100) in 1995 through Ordinance 117977; and

4 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Neighborhood Matching Subfund were
5 transferred to a new Neighborhood Matching Program in the General Fund through
6 Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

7 WHEREAS, the South Lake Union Property Proceeds Subaccount (00167) was created within
8 the Cumulative Reserve Subfund of the General Fund in 2001 through Ordinance
9 120411; and

10 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the South Lake Union Property Proceeds
11 Subaccount were transferred to the General Fund (00100) on January 1, 2018; and

12 WHEREAS, the Street Vacation Compensation Fund (00169) was created as a subfund of the
13 General Fund (00100) in 2001 through Ordinance 120607; and

14 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Street Vacation Compensation Fund
15 were transferred to a new Street Vacation Account in the Transportation Fund (13000)
16 through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

17 WHEREAS, the Bluefield Habitat Maintenance Subaccount (00178) was created within the
18 Cumulative Reserve Subfund of the General Fund in 2011 through Ordinance 123772;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Bluefield Habitat Maintenance
21 Subaccount were transferred to a new Bluefield Habitat Maintenance Account in the
22 General Fund through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

1 WHEREAS, the Development Rights Fund (00179) was created in 1994 through Ordinance
2 117342, and was subsequently re-designated as the Development Rights Subfund of the
3 General Fund (00100) in 1995 through Ordinance 117977; and

4 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Development Rights Subfund were
5 transferred to a new Development Rights Account in the General Fund through
6 Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

7 WHEREAS, the Gasworks Park Contamination Remediation Trust Fund (10220) was created in
8 2000 as a subfund of the Park and Recreation Fund (10200) through Ordinance 120115;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the projects funded through the Gasworks Park Contamination Remediation Fund
11 have been completed, and the residual fund balance, assets, and liabilities were
12 transferred to the Park and Recreation Fund on January 1, 2018; and

13 WHEREAS, the Coliseum Redevelopment Subfund (11420) was created in 1994 pursuant to
14 Ordinance 117139, and subsequently was renamed the Seattle Center KeyArena Subfund;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Seattle Center KeyArena Subfund
17 were transferred to a new Seattle Center KeyArena Fund created through Ordinance
18 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

19 WHEREAS, Ordinance 125724 provided for the fund balance, assets, and liabilities of the
20 Seattle Center KeyArena Fund to be transferred to the Seattle Center Fund (11410),
21 effective January 1, 2019, and

22 WHEREAS, the Education Fund (14100) was created through Ordinance 124650, effective
23 January 1, 2015; and

1 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Education Fund were transferred to the
2 General Fund (00100), the Education – Support Services Fund (17857), and the
3 Preschool Services Fund (17861), according to the City’s commitments of these funds by
4 ordinance, through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018, and

5 WHEREAS, the Mrs. Betty Wile Levy Medical Aid Unit Memorial Account (15180) was
6 created in the General Donations and Gift Trust Fund in 1979 through Ordinance 108395;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the projects funded through the Mrs. Betty Wile Levy Medical Aid Unit Memorial
9 Account have been completed, although unexpended and unencumbered fund balance
10 and other assets remain in the Fund; and

11 WHEREAS, the South Lake Union Subfund (16415) was created within the Low-Income
12 Housing Fund (16400) in 2002 through Ordinance 120944; and

13 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the South Lake Union Subfund were
14 transferred to the new South Lake Union Mitigation Account in the Housing Program
15 Support Fund (16440) through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

16 WHEREAS, the Growth-Related Housing Account (16450) was created within the Low-Income
17 Housing Fund (16400) in 1988 through Ordinance 113834; and

18 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Growth-Related Housing Account
19 were transferred to the Housing Program Support Fund (16440) through Ordinance
20 125492, effective January 1, 2018, and

21 WHEREAS, the Weatherization Program Account (16460) was established within the Low-
22 Income Housing Fund (16400) in 1991 through Ordinance 115647; and

1 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Weatherization Program Account were
2 transferred to the Housing Program Support Fund (16440) through Ordinance 125492,
3 effective January 1, 2018; and

4 WHEREAS, the REACH General Subfund (16470) was created within the Low-Income Housing
5 Fund (16400) in 1994 pursuant to Ordinance 117472; and

6 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the REACH General Subfund were
7 transferred to the new REACH Account in the Housing Program Support Fund (16440)
8 through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

9 WHEREAS, the Housing Preservation Fund (16480) was created as a subfund of the Low-
10 Income Housing Fund (16400) in 1999 through Ordinance 119785; and

11 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the Housing Preservation Fund have been completed,
12 leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund balance, other assets, or liabilities
13 remaining in the Fund; and

14 WHEREAS, the HOME Program Subfund (16490) was created within the Low-Income Housing
15 Fund (16400) in 1992 pursuant to Ordinance 116292; and

16 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the HOME Program Subfund were
17 transferred to the new HOME Account in the Housing Program Support Fund (16440)
18 through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

19 WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Revenue Sharing Fund was created in
20 1975 through Ordinance 104195, and was administratively renamed the Community
21 Development Block Grant Main Fund (17810); and

1 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Community Development Block Grant
2 Main Fund were transferred to the Human Services Fund (16200) through Ordinance
3 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

4 WHEREAS, the 2004 Families and Education Subfund (17856) was established within the
5 Educational and Developmental Services Fund in 2004 through Ordinance 121529; and

6 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the 2004 Families and Education Subfund have been
7 completed, leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund balance, other assets, or
8 liabilities remaining in the Subfund; and

9 WHEREAS, the KeyArena Defeasance Account (20131) was created in the Bond Interest and
10 Redemption Fund in 2002 through Ordinance 120864; and

11 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the KeyArena Defeasance Account have been
12 completed, leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund balance, assets, or liabilities
13 remaining in the Account; and

14 WHEREAS, the McCaw Hall Defeasance Account (20135) was created in the Bond Interest and
15 Redemption Fund in 2006 through Ordinance 122294; and

16 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the McCaw Hall Defeasance Account have been
17 completed, leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund balance, assets, or liabilities
18 remaining in the Account; and

19 WHEREAS, the Pike Place Market Loan Repayment Account (20139) was created in the Bond
20 Interest and Redemption Fund in 2009 pursuant to Ordinance 122848; and

21 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the Pike Place Market Loan Repayment Account have
22 been completed, although unexpended and unencumbered fund balance and other assets
23 remain in the Account; and

1 WHEREAS, the Local Improvement District No. 6748 Fund (25140) was created in 1997
2 through Ordinance 118795; and

3 WHEREAS, the projects funded through the Local Improvement District No. 6748 Fund have
4 been completed, although unexpended and unencumbered fund balance and other assets
5 remain in the Fund; and

6 WHEREAS, the Emergency Communications Fund (32620) was created in 1993 pursuant to
7 Ordinance 116797; and

8 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the Emergency Communications Fund have been
9 completed, and the residual fund balance, assets, and liabilities were transferred to the
10 General Fund (00100) on January 1, 2018; and

11 WHEREAS, the Parks Capital Fund (33140) was created in 2014 through Ordinance 124634;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, all fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Parks Capital Fund were transferred to
14 the Park and Recreation Fund (10200) through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1,
15 2018; and

16 WHEREAS, the Park District Loan Capital Subfund (33141) was created within the Parks
17 Capital Fund (33140) in 2015 pursuant to Ordinance 124652; and

18 WHEREAS, the projects funded through the Park District Loan Capital Subfund of the Parks
19 Capital Fund have been completed, leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund
20 balance, other assets, or liabilities in the Subfund; and

21 WHEREAS, the 1999 Parks and Community Center Fund (33800) was created in 1999 through
22 Ordinance 119522; and

1 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the 1999 Parks and Community Center Fund have been
2 completed, and the residual fund balance, assets, and liabilities were transferred to the
3 General Fund (00100) on January 1, 2018; and

4 WHEREAS, the Non-Bonds Subfund (34410) of the Public Safety Information Technology Fund
5 (34400) was created in 1999 pursuant to Ordinance 119819; and

6 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the Non-Bond Subfund of the Public Safety Information
7 Technology Fund have been completed, and the residual fund balance, assets, and
8 liabilities were transferred to the General Fund (00100) on January 1, 2018; and

9 WHEREAS, the 2007 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35100) was created in 2006 through
10 Ordinance 122121; and

11 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the 2007 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund have been
12 completed, leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund balance, other assets, or
13 liabilities remaining in the Fund; and

14 WHEREAS, the 2008 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35200) was created in 2007 through
15 Ordinance 122553; and

16 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the 2008 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund have been
17 completed, although unexpended and unencumbered fund balance and other assets and
18 liabilities remain in the Fund; and

19 WHEREAS, the 2009 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35300) was created in 2008 through
20 Ordinance 122848; and

21 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the 2009 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund have been
22 completed, although unexpended and unencumbered fund balance and other assets and
23 liabilities remain in the Fund; and

1 WHEREAS, the 2010 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35400) was created in 2009 through
2 Ordinance 123156; and

3 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the 2010 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund have been
4 completed, although unexpended and unencumbered fund balance and other assets and
5 liabilities remain in the Fund; and

6 WHEREAS, the Downtown Parking Garage Fund (46010) was created in 1998 through
7 Ordinance 119155; and

8 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the Downtown Parking Garage Fund have been
9 completed, leaving no unexpended and unencumbered fund balance, other assets, or
10 liabilities remaining in the Fund; and

11 WHEREAS, the Fiber Leasing Fund (47010) was created in 2012 through Ordinance 123931;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Ordinance 125724 provided for the fund balance, assets, and liabilities of the Fiber
14 Leasing Fund to be transferred to the Information Technology Fund (50410), effective
15 January 1, 2019; and

16 WHEREAS, the Help the Animals Account (63601) was established in the General Donations
17 and Gift Trust Fund in 1979 through Ordinance 108357; and

18 WHEREAS, the fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Help the Animals Account of the
19 General Donations and Gift Trust Fund were transferred to the Help the Animals Account
20 in the new Animal Shelter Donation Fund (15260) through Ordinance 125492, effective
21 January 1, 2018; and

22 WHEREAS, the Pet Population Control Fund (63603) was established in the General Donations
23 and Gift Trust Fund in 1996 by Ordinance 118289; and

1 WHEREAS, the fund balance, assets, and liabilities in the Pet Population Control Fund were
2 transferred to the Pet Population Control Account in the new Animal Shelter Donation
3 Fund (15260) through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; and

4 WHEREAS, the Seattle Animal Shelter Expansion Subfund (63604) in the General Donations
5 and Gift Trust Fund was established in 2003 through Ordinance 121307; and

6 WHEREAS, all projects funded through the Seattle Animal Shelter Expansion Subfund have
7 been completed, and residual fund balance, assets, and liabilities were transferred to the
8 Help the Animals Account in the new Animal Shelter Donation Fund (15260) established
9 through Ordinance 125492, effective January 1, 2018; NOW, THEREFORE,

10 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

11 Section 1. The Special Employment Subfund (00515) of the General Fund (00100),
12 established by Ordinance 112556 as amended by Ordinance 117977, is closed and eliminated.

13 Section 2. The Cable Television Franchise Subfund (00160) of the General Fund (00100),
14 created by Ordinance 118196, is closed and eliminated.

15 Section 3. The Neighborhood Matching Subfund (00165) of the General Fund (00100),
16 established by Ordinance 115345 as amended by Ordinance 117977, is closed and eliminated.

17 Section 4. The South Lake Union Property Proceeds Subaccount (00167) within the
18 Cumulative Reserve Subfund of the General Fund (00100), established by Ordinance 120411, is
19 closed and eliminated.

20 Section 5. The Street Vacation Compensation Fund (00169), established by Ordinance
21 120607, is closed and eliminated.

1 Section 6. The Bluefield Habitat Maintenance Subaccount (00178) within the Cumulative
2 Reserve Subfund of the General Fund (00100), established by Ordinance 123772, is closed and
3 eliminated.

4 Section 7. The Development Rights Subfund (00179) of the General Fund (00100),
5 established by Ordinance 117342 as amended by Ordinance 117977, is closed and eliminated.

6 Section 8. The Gasworks Park Contamination Remediation Trust Fund (10220) of the
7 Park and Recreation Fund (10200), established by Ordinance 120115, is closed and eliminated.

8 Section 9. The Seattle Center KeyArena Fund (11420), established pursuant to Ordinance
9 117139, as amended by Ordinance 125492, is closed and eliminated.

10 Section 10. The Education Fund (14100), established by Ordinance 124650, is closed and
11 eliminated.

12 Section 11. The Mrs. Betty Wile Levy Medical Aid Unit Memorial Account (15180) in
13 the General Donations and Gift Trust Fund, established by Ordinance 108395, is closed and
14 eliminated. Any unencumbered fund balance, asset, or liability remaining in the Fund shall be
15 transferred to the General Fund (00100) using the Finance General Appropriation to Special
16 Funds Budget Summary Level/BCL Code (15180-BO-FG-2QA00).

17 Section 12. The South Lake Union Subfund (16415) within the Low-Income Housing
18 Fund (16400), established by Ordinance 120944, is closed and eliminated.

19 Section 13. The Growth-Related Housing Account (16450) within the Low-Income
20 Housing Fund (16400), established by Ordinance 113834, is closed and eliminated.

21 Section 14. The Weatherization Program Account (16460) within the Low-Income
22 Housing Fund (16400), established by Ordinance 115647, is closed and eliminated.

1 Section 15. The REACH General Subfund (16470) within the Low-Income Housing
2 Fund (16400), established by Ordinance 117472, is closed and eliminated.

3 Section 16. The Housing Preservation Fund (16480) within the Low-Income Housing
4 Fund (16400), established by Ordinance 119785, is closed and eliminated.

5 Section 17. The HOME Program Subfund (16490) within the Low-Income Housing Fund
6 (16400), established by Ordinance 116292, is closed and eliminated.

7 Section 18. The Community Development Block Grant Main Fund (17810), established
8 by Ordinance 104195, is closed and eliminated.

9 Section 19. The 2004 Families and Education Subfund (17856), established by Ordinance
10 121529, is closed and eliminated.

11 Section 20. The KeyArena Defeasance Account (20131) of the Bond Interest and
12 Redemption Fund, established by Ordinance 120864, is closed and eliminated.

13 Section 21. The McCaw Hall Defeasance Account (20135) of the Bond Interest and
14 Redemption Fund, established by Ordinance 122294, is closed and eliminated.

15 Section 22. The Pike Place Market Loan Repayment Account (20139) of the Bond
16 Interest and Redemption Fund, established pursuant to Ordinance 122848, is closed and
17 eliminated. Any unencumbered fund balance, asset, or liability remaining in the Account shall be
18 transferred to the General Fund (00100) using the Finance General Appropriation to Special
19 Funds Budget Summary Level/BCL Code (20139-BO-FG-2QA00).

20 Section 23. The Local Improvement District No. 6748 (25140), established by Ordinance
21 118795, is closed and eliminated. Any unencumbered fund balance, asset, or liability remaining
22 in the Fund shall be transferred to the Local Improvement Guaranty Fund (29500) using the

1 Finance General Appropriation to Special Funds Budget Summary Level/BCL Code (25140-BO-
2 FG-2QA00).

3 Section 24. The Emergency Communications Fund (32620), established by Ordinance
4 116797, is closed and eliminated.

5 Section 25. The Parks Capital Fund (33140), created by Ordinance 124634, is closed and
6 eliminated.

7 Section 26. The Park District Loan Capital Subfund (33141) of the Parks Capital Fund
8 (33140), created pursuant to Ordinance 124652, is closed and eliminated.

9 Section 27. The 1999 Parks and Community Center Fund (33800), established by
10 Ordinance 119522, is closed and eliminated.

11 Section 28. The Non-Bonds Subfund (34410) of the Public Safety Information
12 Technology Fund (34400), established pursuant to Ordinance 119819, is closed and eliminated.

13 Section 29. The 2007 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35100), established by Ordinance
14 122121, is closed and eliminated.

15 Section 30. The 2008 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35200), established by Ordinance
16 122553, is closed and eliminated. Any unencumbered fund balance, asset, or liability remaining
17 in the Fund shall be transferred to the LTGO Bond Interest and Redemption Fund (20130) using
18 the Finance General Appropriation to Special Funds Budget Summary Level/BCL Code (35200-
19 BO-FG-2QA00).

20 Section 31. The 2009 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35300), established by Ordinance
21 122848, is closed and eliminated. Any unencumbered fund balance, asset, or liability remaining
22 in the Fund shall be transferred to the LTGO Bond Interest and Redemption Fund (20130) using

1 the Finance General Appropriation to Special Funds Budget Summary Level/BCL Code (35300-
2 BO-FG-2QA00).

3 Section 32. The 2010 Multipurpose LTGO Bond Fund (35400), established by Ordinance
4 123156, is closed and eliminated. Any unencumbered fund balance, asset, or liability remaining
5 in the Fund shall be transferred to the LTGO Bond Interest and Redemption Fund (20130) using
6 the Finance General Appropriation to Special Funds Budget Summary Level/BCL Code (35400-
7 BO-FG-2QA00).

8 Section 33. The Downtown Parking Garage Fund (46010), established by Ordinance
9 119155, is closed and eliminated.

10 Section 34. The Fiber Leasing Fund (47010), established by Ordinance 123931, is closed
11 and eliminated.

12 Section 35. The Help the Animals Account (63601) in the General Donations and Gift
13 Trust Fund, established by Ordinance 108357, is closed and eliminated.

14 Section 36. The Pet Population Control Fund (63603) in the General Donations and Gift
15 Trust Fund, established by Ordinance 118289, is closed and eliminated.


16 Section 37. The Seattle Animal Shelter Expansion Subfund (63604) in the General
17 Donations and Gift Trust Fund, established by Ordinance 121307, is closed and eliminated.

18 Section 38. Any remaining appropriation authority from any fund, subfund, or account
19 closed pursuant to Sections 1 through 37 of this ordinance is abandoned.

20 Section 39. The Department of Finance and Administrative Services is authorized to take
21 any action necessary to effectuate the closures, eliminations, and abandonments made by this
22 ordinance.


1 Section 40. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by
