He also has a passion for adaptive re-use, as evidenced by his rehabilitations of the Paramount Theatre, Union Station, the Eames (now PACCAR) IMAX Theater at the Pacific Science Center, and the State and Burke Building on Occidental Mall.

Prior to joining NBBJ, John was with Olson Walker in Seattle and Marcel Breuer Associates in New York City.
