City-funded Public Restrooms

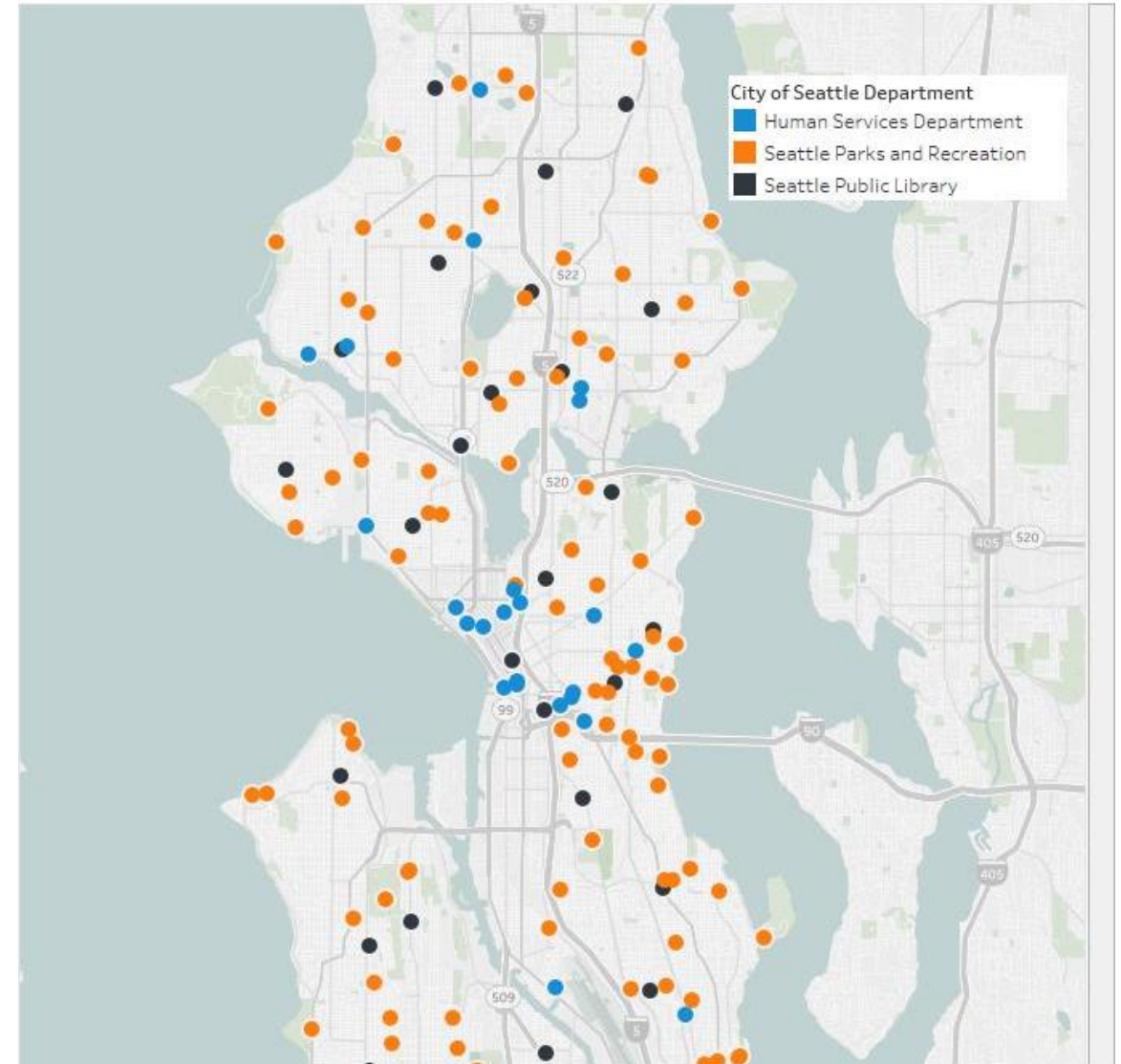
- **117 Public Restrooms in:**
