WHEREAS, Council adopted a proviso on this funding that no funding could be spent until 15 16 authorized by future ordinance; and 17 WHEREAS, Council anticipated that authority would not be granted until the Libraries, Utilities, and Center Committee had reviewed and approved the proposed consultant scope of work 18 for the development of a Memorial Stadium Action Plan; and 19 WHEREAS, Seattle Center has determined that this funding would more appropriately be used 20 for a Strategic Parking Study and Real Estate consultant to continue discussions around 21 the future use of Memorial Stadium and other Seattle Center spaces; and 22 WHEREAS, REET I is not an eligible funding source for this type of work but can be swapped 23 for funding with other Capital Projects within Seattle Center to accomplish this objective 24 25 without changing the overall funding authority within Seattle Center; NOW, 26 THEREFORE,

King County Metro Transit, the Monorail and other modes of transportation.

Work may include, but is not limited to, hard surface repairs, demolition of existing structures, creation of new green space, installation of recreation facilities, and renovation and repurposing of existing structures. Center Art, LLC is contributing \$1 million in private funds for design and construction of an artist-designed children's play area on the former north Fun Forest site, with opening planned for Spring 2015. Center Art is also contributing \$50,000 per year for maintenance of the play area.
