

They joined the Commission in 2016 after moving here from Texas, where they trained other people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) in Texas' state institutions and community on advocacy, as well as advocating on issues like community living and employment. Shaun is also the Secretary of Self-Advocates in Leadership, an advocacy group for people with I/DD, and has traveled around the country to present on topics of disability justice. Former member of Texas' Employment First Task Force, they have been organizing against the practice of paying disabled workers subminimum wages for years, and recently lead Seattle to become the first city in the country to ban the practice.
