
# Food and Meals Portfolio Overview

Desired Result: Ensure all people in Seattle have self-determined access to healthy, affordable, culturally appropriate food.



# Child and Youth Nutrition

- Seattle children and youth, birth to 18, have access to healthy foods and information to make good lasting choices.



# Child Care Nutrition Program

- Healthy meals for children ages birth through 12
- 130 family home child care providers
- Focus on increasing whole grains and vegetables and reducing sugar



# Out-of-School-Time Meals Program

- After School Meals
- Summer Food Service Program



# After School Meals Program

- Launched in Fall 2018
- Pilot year with 5 sites
- Serves youth 5 to 18
- New sites will be added in Fall 2019
- Out of school time includes:
  - Summer
  - Mid-winter break
  - Spring break




# Summer Food Service Program

- 120 sites across Seattle
- Serve low-income children, youth, and communities
- Open to ages 18 and under




# Summer Food Service Program
