**a. Legislation Title:**

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 125205, which conditioned the Seattle Department of Transportation's 2017 grant applications and repealed Ordinance 118719.

**b. Summary and background of the Legislation:**

The Council passed Ordinance 125205 in November 2016, which restricts the projects in the CIP that SDOT can apply for grants during 2017 that are over 5 million dollars. SDOT has determined, based on the readiness of the Roosevelt Multimodal Corridor project, that it would be a good candidate for the Federal Transit Administration's 2017 Small Starts application cycle in September.
