CITY OF SEATTLE 1 ORDINANCE 125 2 COUNCIL BILL 118731 3 4 AN ORDINANCE relating to historic preservation; imposing controls upon The Theodora, a 5 landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Board under Chapter 25.12 of the 6 Seattle Municipal Code, and adding it to the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in 7 Chapter 25.32 of the Seattle Municipal Code. 8 9 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal 10 Code (SMC), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of sites, 11 improvements, and objects having historical, cultural, architectural, engineering, or 12 geographic significance; and 13 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board"), after a public meeting on August 20, 14 2014, voted to approve the nomination of the improvement located at 6559 35th Avenue 15 NE and the site on which the improvement is located (which collectively are referred to 16 as "The Theodora" for the purposes of this ordinance) for designation as a landmark 17 under SMC Chapter 25.12; and 18 WHEREAS, after a public meeting on October 1, 2014, the Board voted to approve the 19 designation of The Theodora under SMC Chapter 25.12; and 20 WHEREAS, on December 2, 2015, the Board and the owner of the designated landmark agreed 21 to controls and incentives; and 22 WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council enact a designating ordinance 23 approving the controls and incentives; NOW, THEREFORE, 24 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: 25 Section 1. DESIGNATION: Pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.12.660, the 26 designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board") of the improvement located at 6559 27

Dlb Section 2. CONTROLS: The following controls are hereby imposed on the features or 1 characteristics of The Theodora that were designated by the Board for preservation: 2 3 A. Certificate of Approval Process. Except as provided in subsection 2.A.2 or subsection 2.B of this 4 1. ordinance, the owner must obtain a Certificate of Approval issued by the Board pursuant to SMC 5 6 Chapter 25.12, or the time for denying a Certificate of Approval must have expired, before the owner may make alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics of The 7 Theodora that were designated by the Board for preservation. 8 9 2. No Certificate of Approval is required for the following: Any in-kind maintenance or repairs of the features or 10 a. characteristics of The Theodora that were designated by the Board for preservation. 11 ADA signage. 12 b. A text change to any previously approved sign, provided that there 13 c. are no design changes to font, letter size, color, material, or any other aspect of the sign's design 14 or installation. 15 Removal of the following landscape elements: trees less than 8 d. 16 inches in diameter measured 4 1/2 feet above ground; shrubs; perennials; and annuals. 17 Installation, removal, or alteration of temporary site furnishings, 18 e. including benches, movable planters, and trash receptacles. 19 Installation or repair of underground utilities and irrigation, f. 20

provided that the site is restored in kind.

B. City Historic Preservation Officer Approval Process.

- 1. The City Historic Preservation Officer (CHPO) may review and approve alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.B.3 of this ordinance according to the following procedure:
- a. The owner shall submit to the CHPO a written request for the alterations or significant changes, including applicable drawings or specifications.
- b. If the CHPO, upon examination of submitted plans and specifications, determines that the alterations or significant changes are consistent with the purposes of SMC Chapter 25.12, the CHPO shall approve the alterations or significant changes without further action by the Board.
- 2. If the CHPO does not approve the alterations or significant changes, the owner may submit revised materials to the CHPO, or apply to the Board for a Certificate of Approval under SMC Chapter 25.12. The CHPO shall transmit a written decision on the owner's request to the owner within 14 days of receipt of the request. Failure of the CHPO to timely transmit a written decision constitutes approval of the request.
- 3. CHPO approval of alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics of The Theodora that were designated by the Board for preservation is available for the following:
- a. For the specified features and characteristics of the building, the addition or elimination of ducts, conduits, HVAC vents, grilles, fire escapes, pipes, and other similar wiring or mechanical elements necessary for the normal operation of the building.
- b. Installation, removal, or alterations of exterior light fixtures, including exterior security lighting, and security system equipment.

1	c. Signage other than signage excluded in subsections 2.A.2.b or
2	2.A.2.c of this ordinance.
3	d. Removal of hazardous trees more than 8 inches in diameter
4	measured 4 1/2 feet above ground.
5	Section 3. <u>INCENTIVES</u> : The following incentives are hereby granted on the features or
6	characteristics of The Theodora that were designated by the Board for preservation:
7	A. Uses not otherwise permitted in a zone may be authorized in a designated
8	landmark by means of an administrative conditional use permit issued pursuant to SMC Title 23.
9	B. Exceptions to certain of the requirements of the Seattle Building Code, SMC
10	Chapter 22.100, and the Seattle Energy Code, SMC Chapter 22.700, may be authorized pursuant
11	to the applicable provisions thereof.
12	C. Special tax valuation for historic preservation may be available under RCW
13	Chapter 84.26 upon application and compliance with the requirements of that statute.
14	D. Reduction or waiver, under certain conditions, of minimum accessory off-street
15	parking requirements for uses permitted in a designated landmark structure may be permitted
16	pursuant to SMC Title 23.
17	Section 4. Enforcement of this ordinance and penalties for its violation are as provided in
18	SMC 25.12.910.
19	Section 5. The Theodora is hereby added alphabetically to Section II, Buildings, of the
20	Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32.

2	the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3	shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
