<u>Insert a new Section after Section 1 of Council Bill 120171 as follows and renumber sections accordingly:</u>

Section 2. The Seattle Fire Department shall submit revised SIRs for Emergency Scene

Cameras and for Hazardous Materials Cameras to the Clerk within 30 days after the conclusion

of the Department's next labor negotiations. The revised SIRs must include additional policies

and/or guidelines governing the use and operation of Emergency Scene Cameras and

Hazardous Materials Cameras, including measures to protect for the privacy of individuals and

homes, record retention schedules, protocols for data sharing with law enforcement, and

training.

**Effect:** Requires the Seattle Fire Department (SFD) to submit revised Surveillance Impact Reports (SIRs) to the Clerk with additional policies and/or guidelines governing the use and operation of Emergency Scene Cameras and Hazardous Materials Cameras by a date after the conclusion of SFD's upcoming labor negotiations. The revised SIRs must include policies and/or guidelines to protect for the privacy of individuals and homes, record retention schedules, protocols for data sharing with law enforcement, and training.
