New connection provides pedestrian access from Burke-Gilman Trail to Children's Hospital and nearby community



Easement agreement will provide maintenance of connector trail in perpetuity

- Maintenance and repair of the trail connection, including landscape and hardscape, is the responsibility of Children's Hospital through the Trail Maintenance Agreement.
- The Trail Easement Agreement provides terms and conditions of trail usage and further protects the City through defining indemnification, liability and access requirements.

Trail provides safe, tranquil passage from Burke-Gilman Trail to hospital and Sand Point Way NE

- This is the result of planning and cooperation between two city departments and the medical facility, and is part of the Livable Streets Initiative to provide safer pedestrian transportation options.
- The connector trail is landscaped, lighted, paved with concrete and has a railing.
- The connector trail, which spans both City and hospital property, will be maintained by Children's in perpetuity at no cost to the City.
