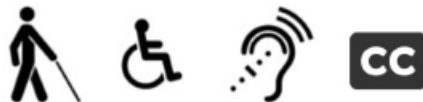

**\*Notice of Public Comment relating to Resolution 31913**

As part of this meeting, the Seattle City Council intends to vote on Resolution No. 31913, entitled, 'A RESOLUTION concerning Washington Referendum Measure No. 88 ("Referendum 88"), proposing voter approval of Initiative Measure No. 1000, and urging Seattle voters to vote "Approved" on Referendum 88 on the November 5, 2019, general election ballot.'

Title of Referendum Measure No. 88 is below:

The legislature passed Initiative Measure No. 1000 concerning affirmative action and remedying discrimination, and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this act. Initiative 1000 would allow the state to remedy discrimination for certain groups and to implement affirmative action, without the use of quotas or preferential treatment (as defined), in public education, employment, and contracting.

Should Initiative 1000 be:

- Approved
- Rejected

As provided for under RCW 42.17A.555 and Seattle Municipal Code 2.04.300, the City Council will afford members of the public an opportunity at the October 21, 2019, City Council meeting to express a view that is in support or opposed to the proposed City Council Resolution 31913. An equal opportunity will be given to proponents and opponents of the measure.

The City Council meeting on October 21st will begin at 2:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber at 600 Fourth Avenue, 2nd floor. A sign-up sheet will be available at 1:45 p.m. Speakers will be drawn from the sign-up list in the order in which names appear and until the time allotted to members of the public is exhausted. Note that not all members of the public who sign up are guaranteed an opportunity to speak.
