Overall 2019 Trends

Citywide

- **2019 violent crime was down 3% compared to 2018**

West Precinct

- **Violent crime was up 3% over 2018**
 - **Biggest drivers were increases in reported aggravated assault and rapes**

Downtown Core

- **Violent crime was down 5% over 2018**
 - **Biggest driver of crime is aggravated assaults**

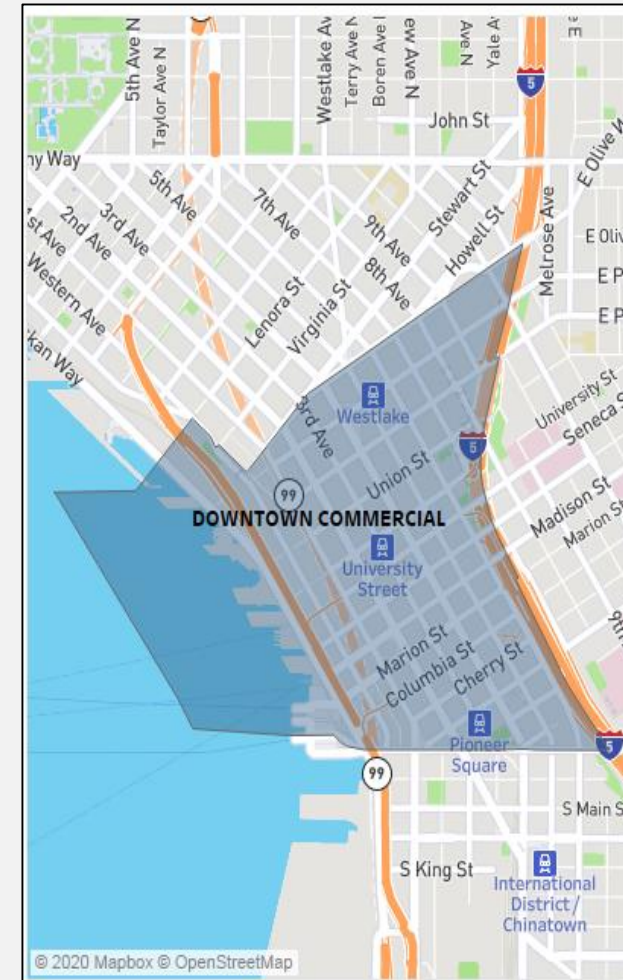

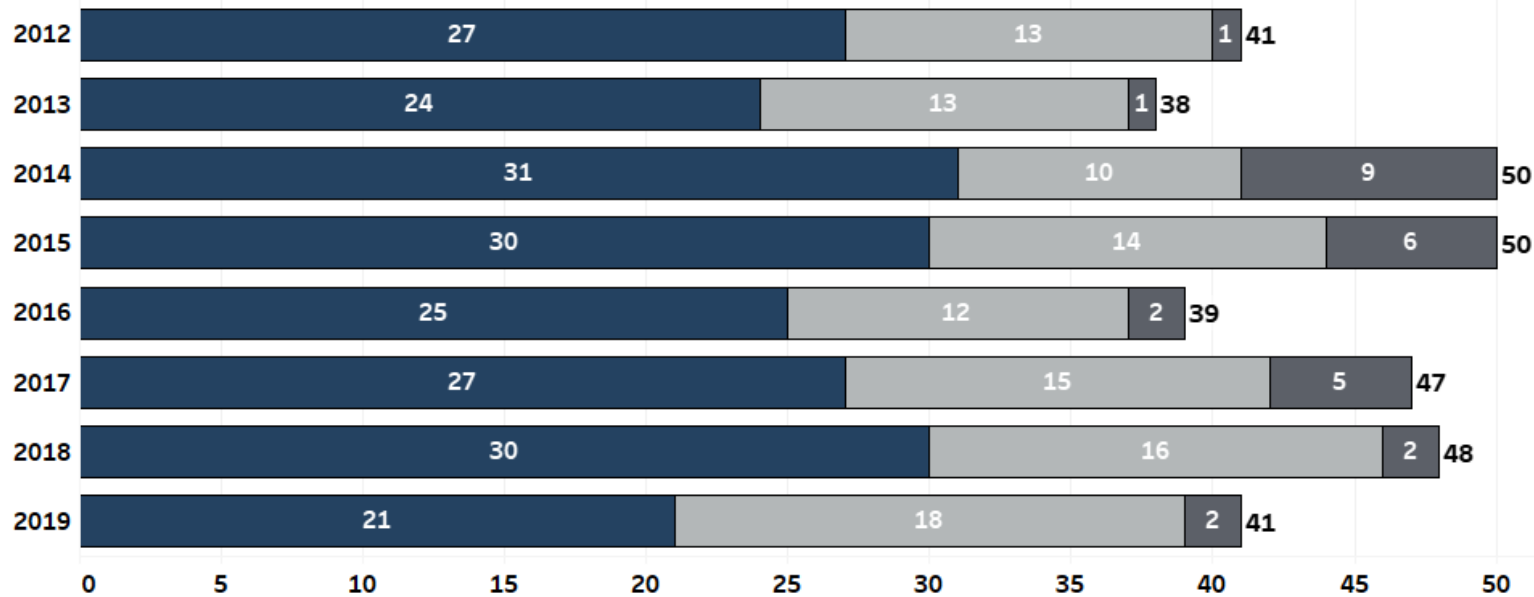

■ Shots Fired ■ Non-Fatal Shootings ■ Fatal Shootings



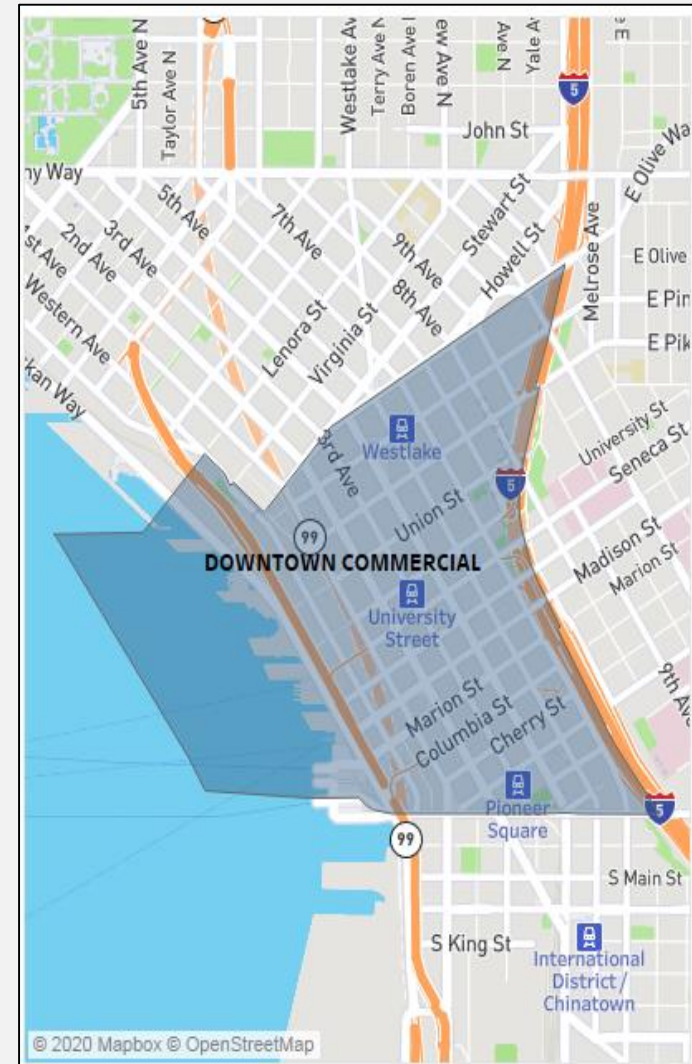
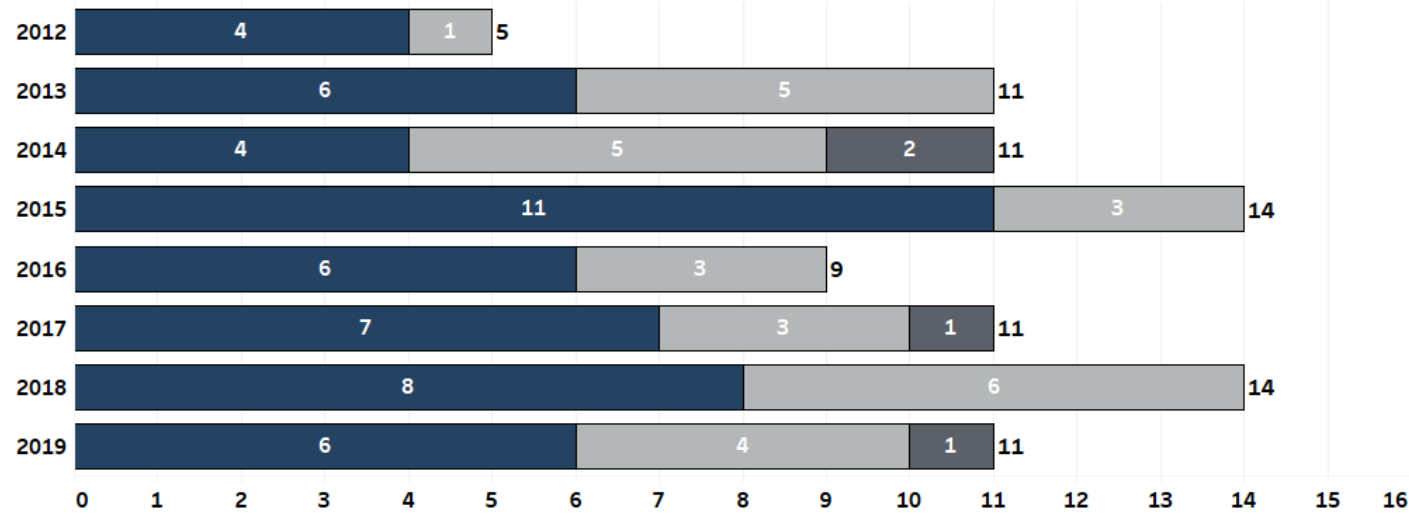

Immediate Response Plans

“Westlake Precinct” & Proactive First Responders

- Mobile Precinct as base
- High-Visibility Foot & Bike beats in the immediate area
- Rotating non-911 responders to augment West Precinct resources
- Focus work of new CSOs and MHPs
- Expansion of SFD’s HealthOne resource mid-year





Investigation & Intervention

- Continue arresting shooters
- Augment Gang Unit to intercede in on-going conflict
- Work with community organizations to stop the violence, change behaviors, and prevent engaging in gang/violent activity
- Partner with prosecuting attorneys to focus resources on most significant violent/criminal actors



Physical Environment & Activation

- City coordinated effort around Third Avenue and Pike/Pine Corridor Improvements
- Additional CPTED Reviews
- Potential activation of vacant property and storefronts
- Strategies with KC Metro and Sound Transit related to bus stops and tunnel entrances

Community Partnerships and Collaboration

- Mayor's Office convening ongoing working group with business and resident leaders
- Engaging businesses and residents through OED and DON
- Mayor and Chief meeting with business owners, workers, and resident, directly
