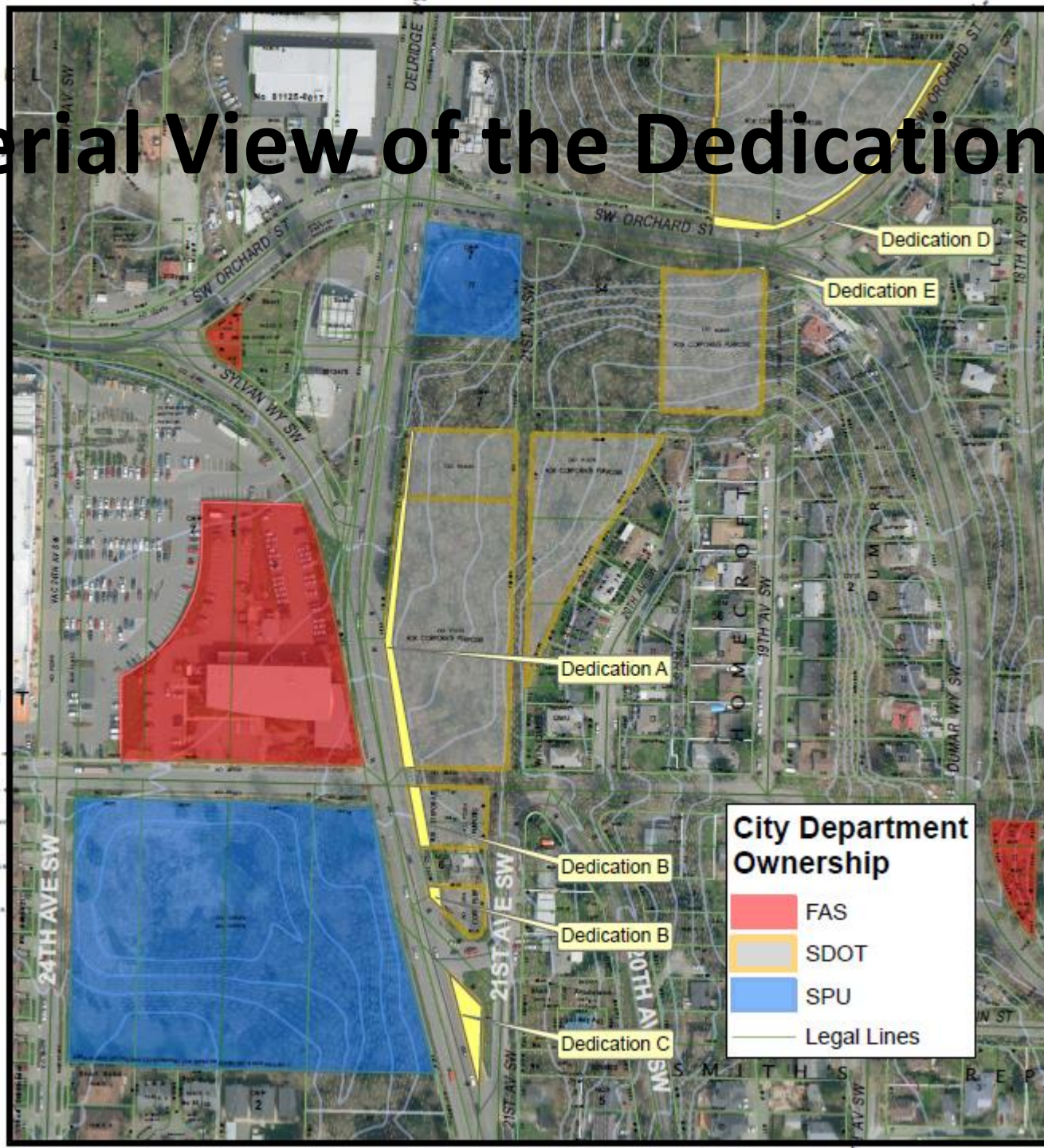

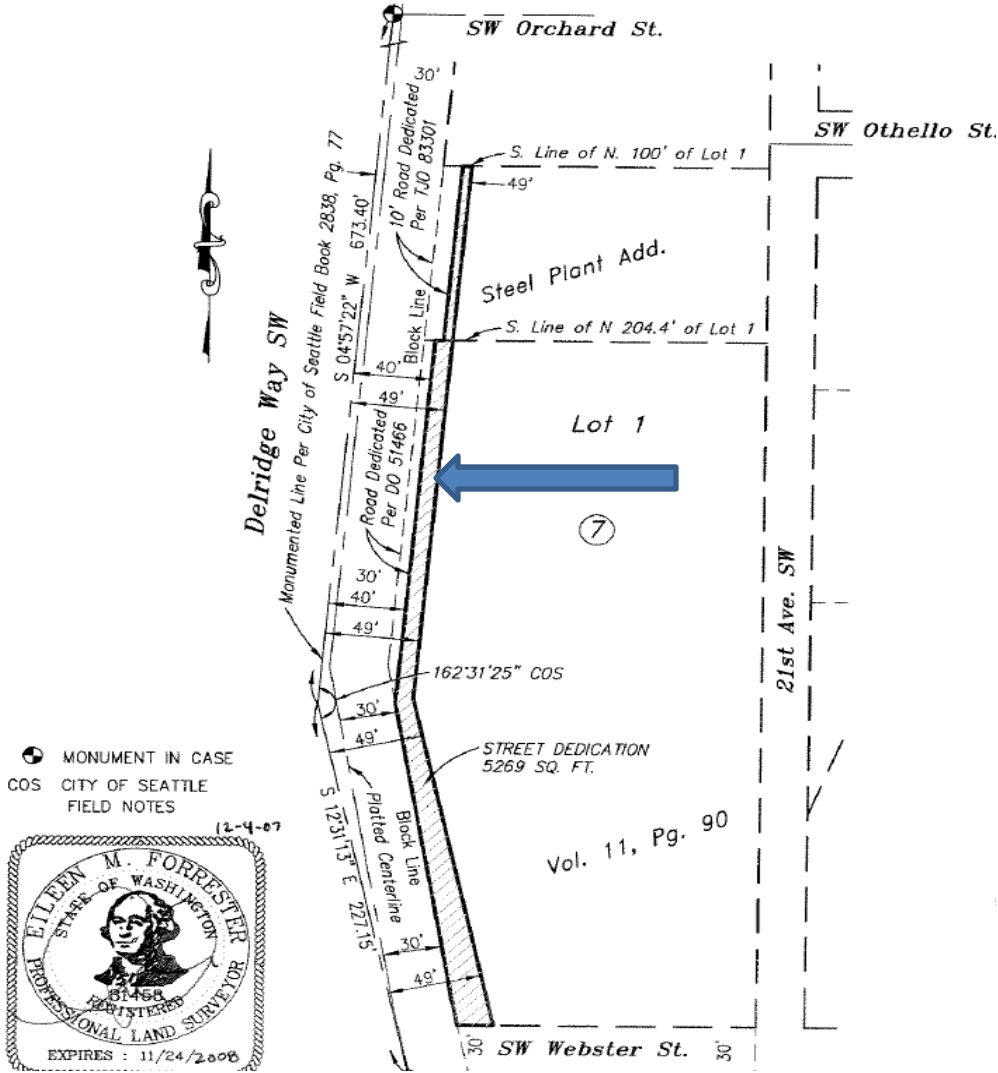
BACKGROUND

- The street widenings have been completed and the following portions of properties are currently functioning as right of way

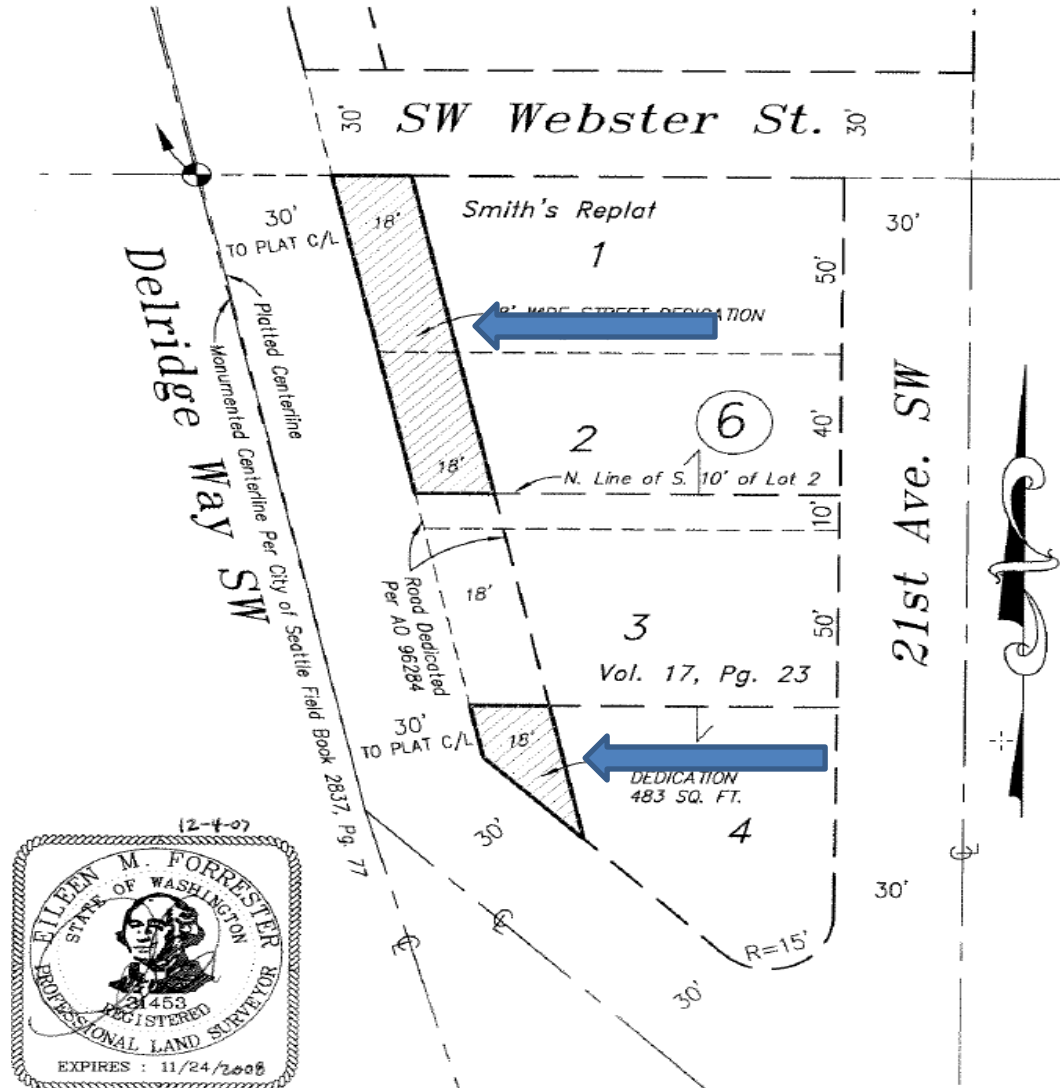

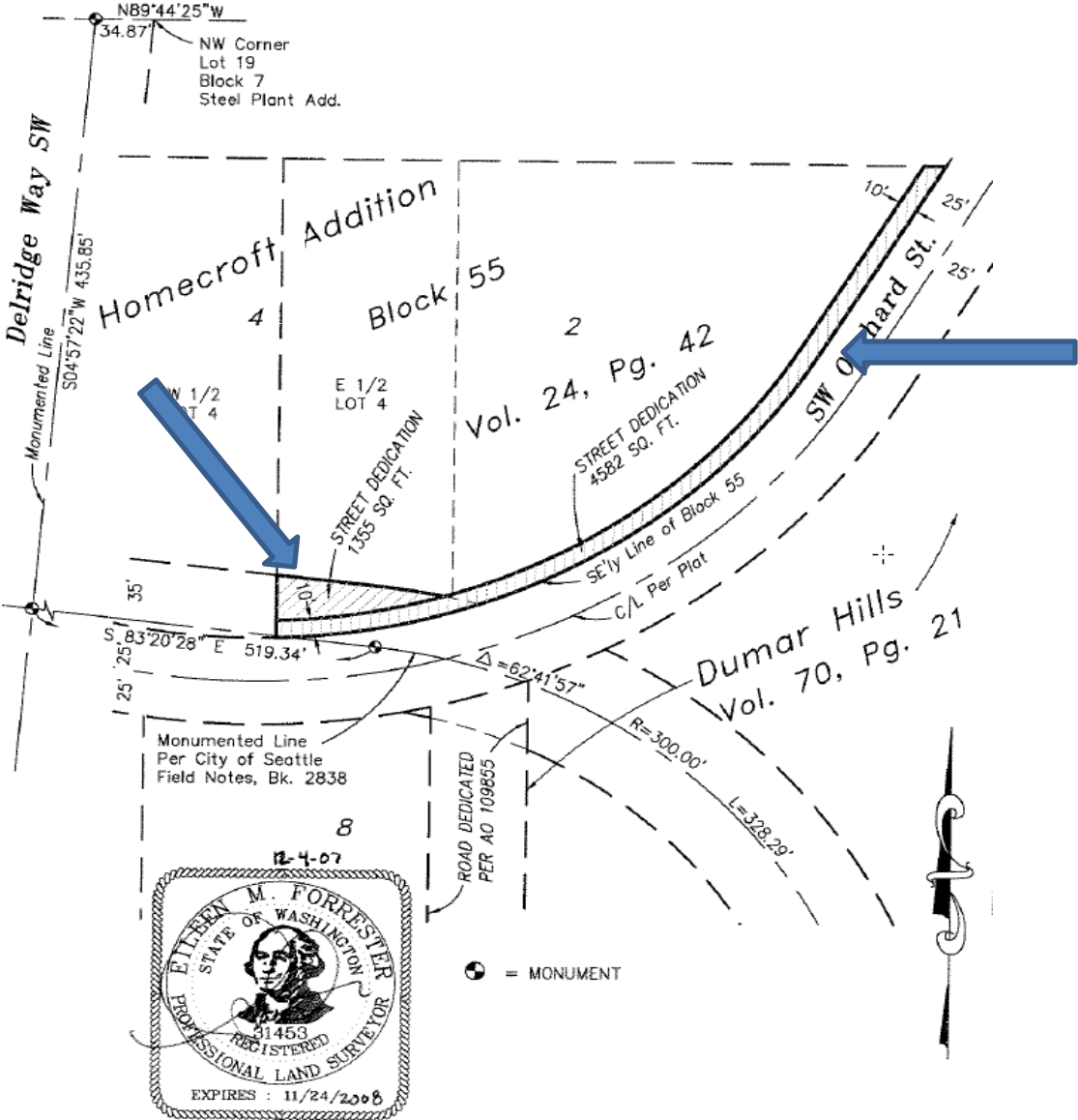
Aerial View of Dedication A



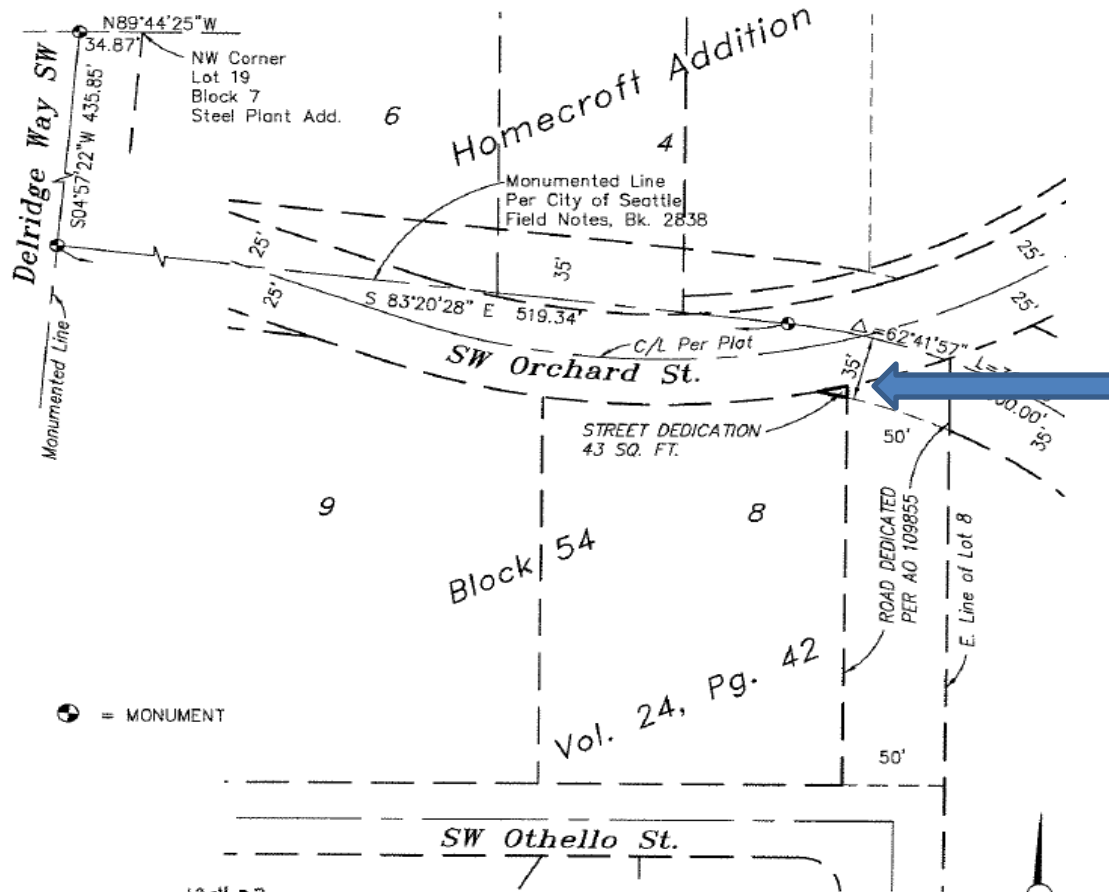
