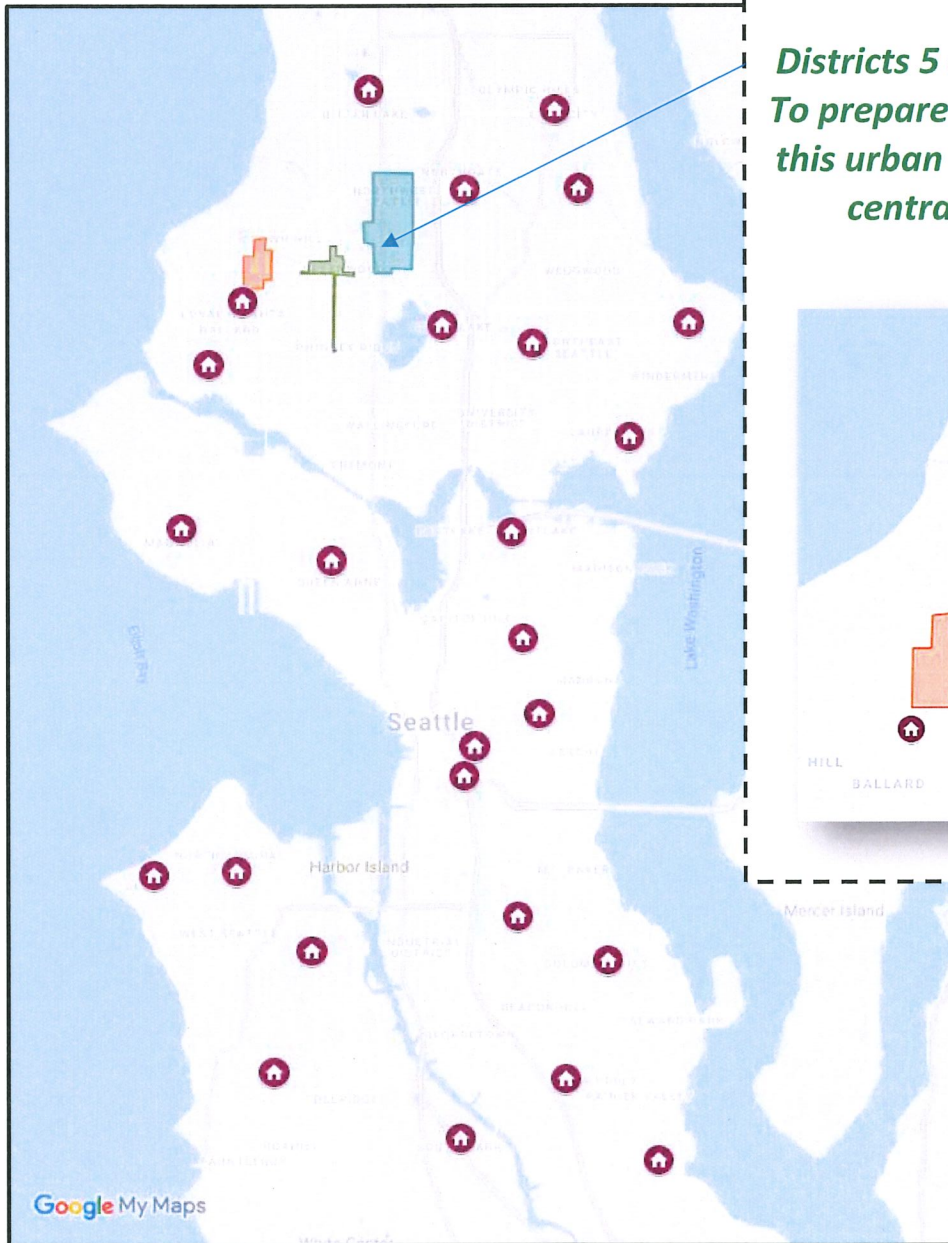

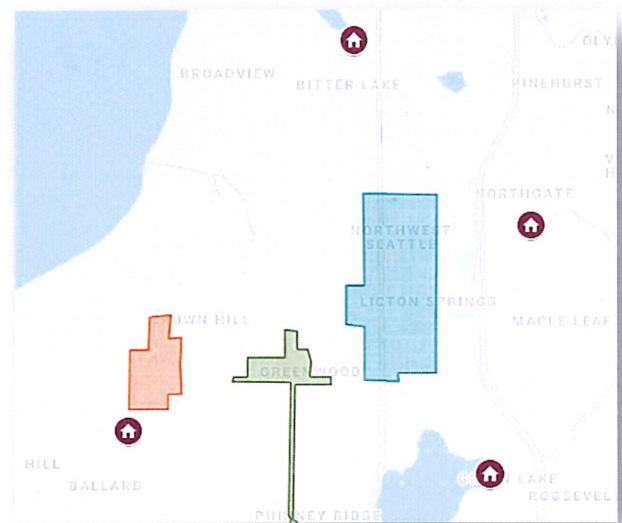
City of Seattle Community Centers

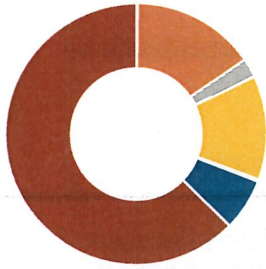
Districts 5 and 6 are rapidly densifying. To prepare for the growth of the future, this urban region needs and deserves a centralized community center.
