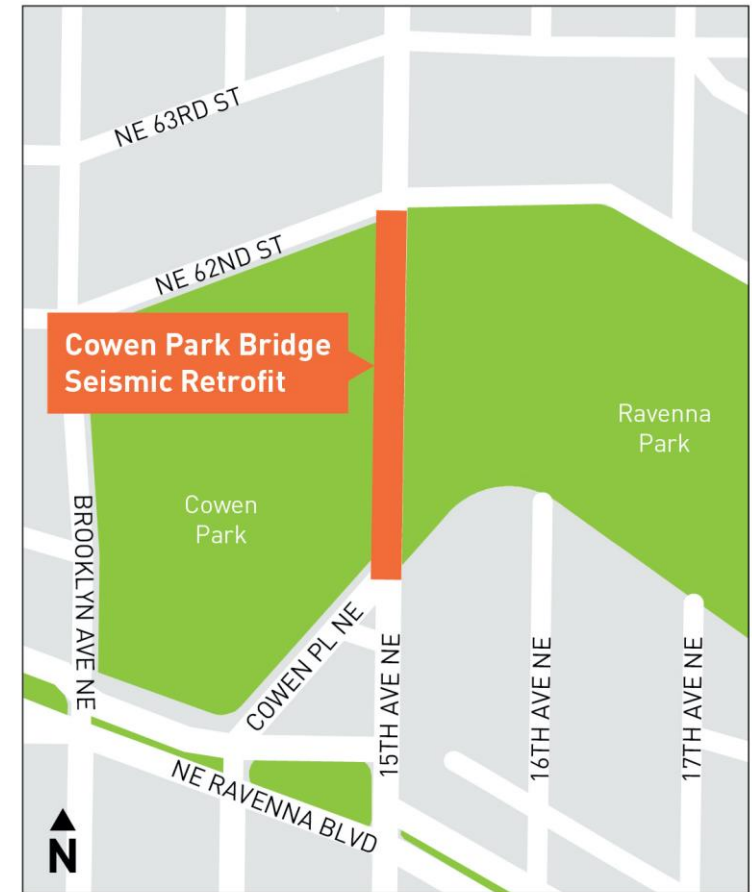

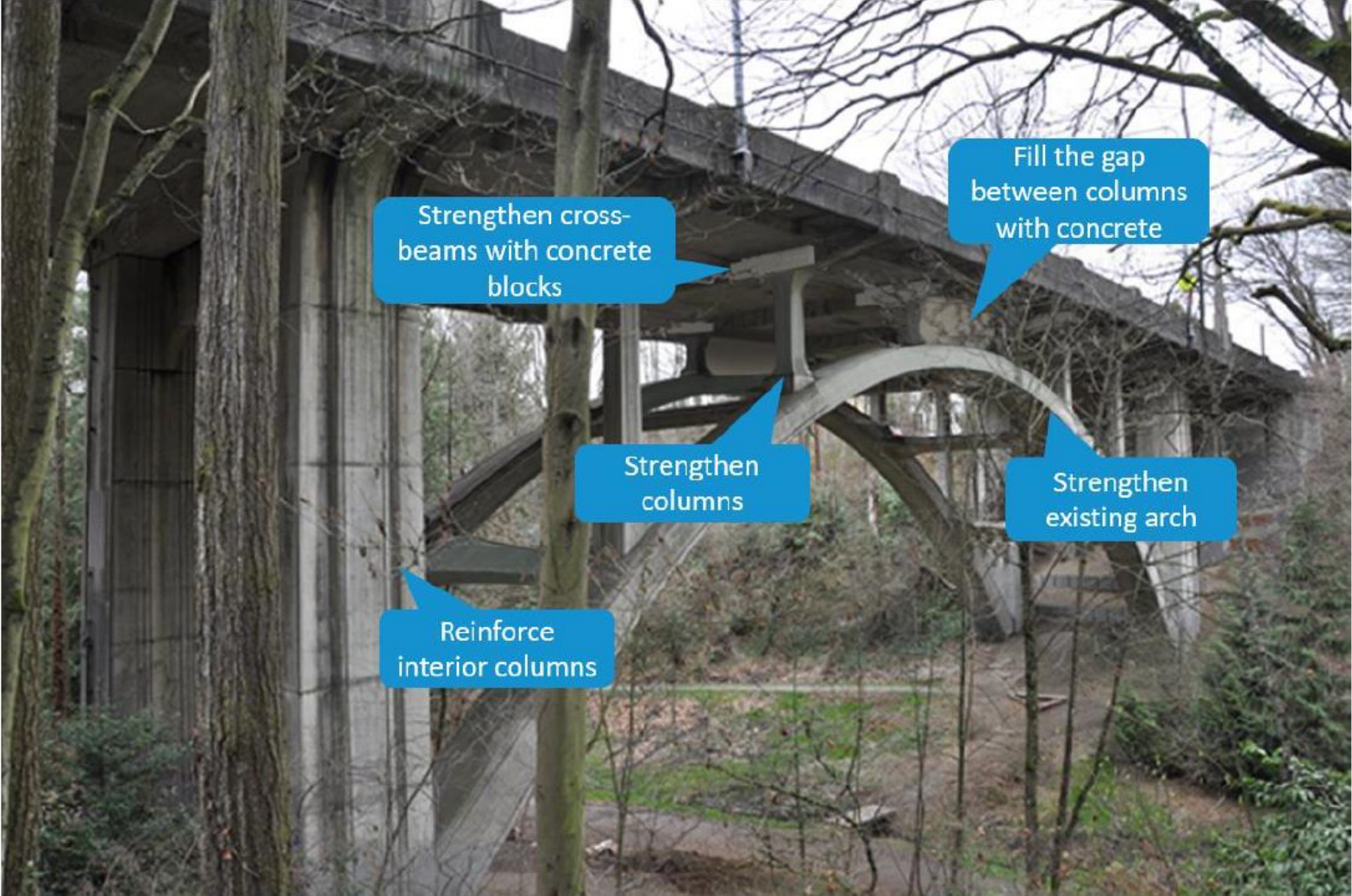
Cowen Park Bridge - Contingent Grant Authority

Background

- Authorizes contingent acceptance of \$602,465 in federal Surface Transportation Funds (PSRC)
 - Grant application was authorized by [ordinance 125471](#);
 - placed on contingency list by PSRC
 - PSRC is now needing to pull projects from the contingency list to meet its 2019
- City needs to obligate by July 15 to accept funds
 - Ratify and confirm clause
 - Construction this summer, complete early next year
- Ability to accept STP funds for Cowen Park Bridge Seismic
 - Frees up Levy to Move Seattle Seismic Bridge funds to be reprogrammed to other Bridge Seismic Rehab projects
