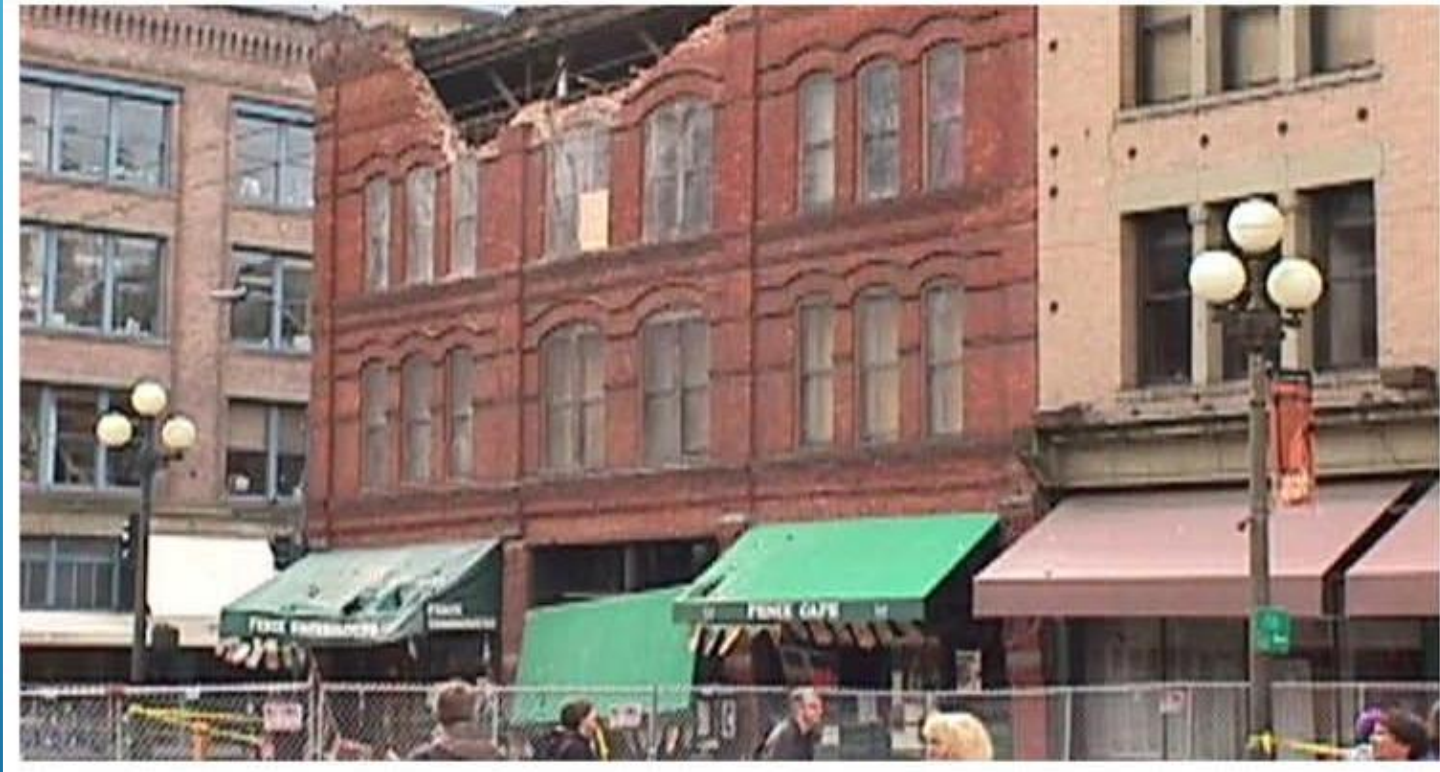

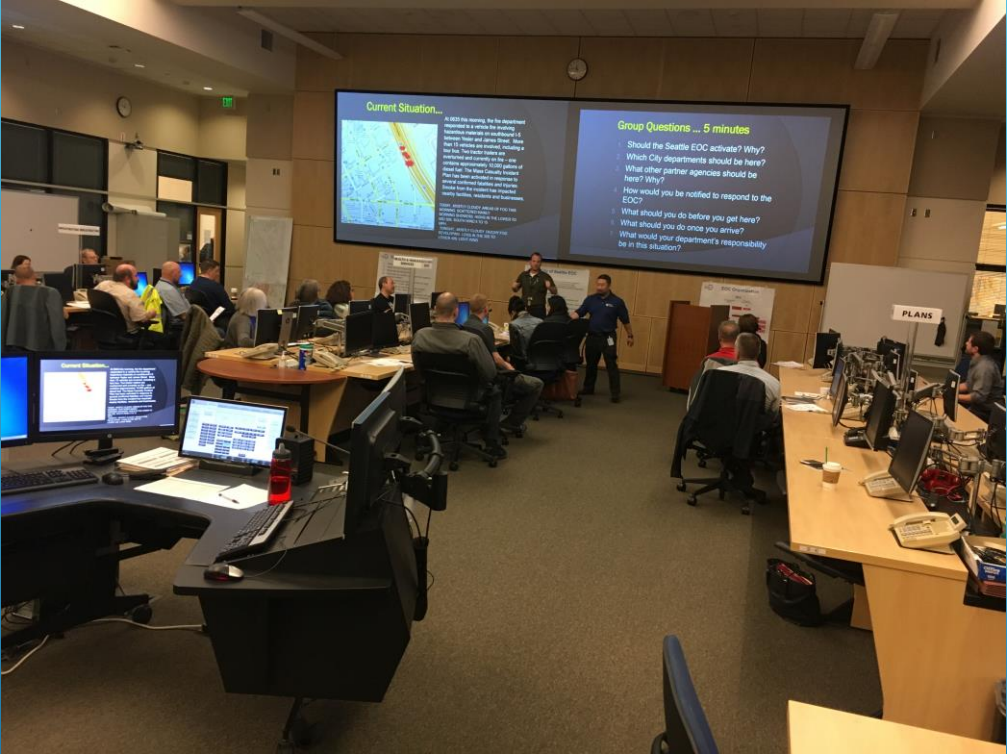

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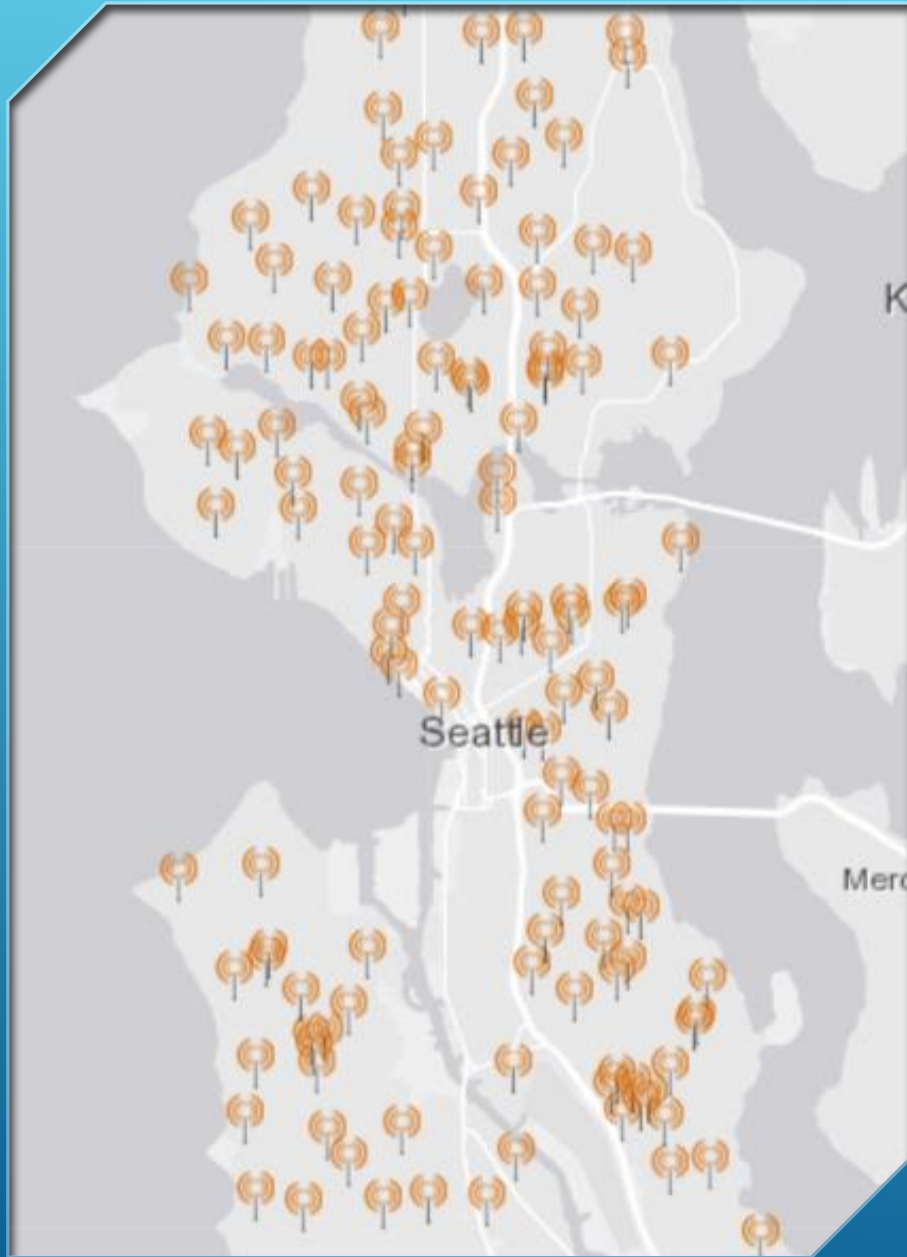
COLUMBIA STREET AREAWAY SEISMIC PROJECT GRANT

EOC ACTIVATIONS AND STAFF DUTY OFFICER ASSISTANCE

- ▶ Inauguration Day, January 20
 - ▶ Womxn's March, January 21
 - ▶ Winter weather, February 6-7
 - ▶ Homelessness, (began) February 22
 - ▶ Overturned tanker, February 27
 - ▶ Fiber optic cable cut, March 8
 - ▶ May Day, May 1
 - ▶ Pride Parade, June 25
 - ▶ Torchlight Parade, July 29
 - ▶ New Year's Eve, December 31
- ▶ Office of Emergency Management Staff Duty Officer monitored or coordinated an additional 48 events over the course of the year including marches, storms, power outages, etc.



OUTREACH

- 11,710 people attended programs and events
- 232 preparedness programs taught
- 518 people attended a disaster skills class
- 236 people attended a home retrofit class
- 90 new post-disaster hub locations were identified

VOLUNTEERS

- Planning, research, and project volunteers contributed 686 hours in 2017
