- **Mission:** to improve the lives of Seattle's immigrant and refugee families.

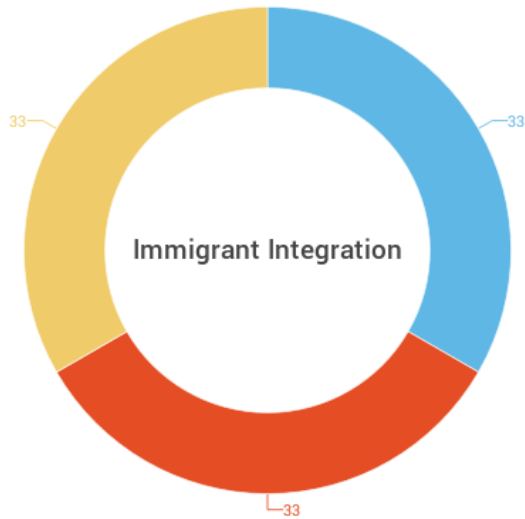


Since 2014

Donald Trump's Contract with the American Voter

What follows is my **100-day action plan to Make America Great Again.**

It is a contract between myself and the American voter—and begins with restoring honesty and accountability, and bringing change to Washington.

On the first day of my term of office, my administration will immediately pursue the following:

Six measures to clean up the corruption and special interest collusion in Washington, DC:

- ★ **FIRST**, propose a constitutional amendment to impose term limits on all members of Congress.
- ★ **SECOND**, a hiring freeze on all federal employees to reduce the federal workforce through attrition (exempting military, public safety, and public health).
- ★ **THIRD**, a requirement that for every new federal regulation, two existing regulations must be eliminated.
- ★ **FOURTH**, a five-year ban on White House and Congressional officials becoming lobbyists after they leave government service.
- ★ **FIFTH**, a lifetime ban on White House officials lobbying on behalf of a foreign government.
- ★ **SIXTH**, a complete ban on foreign lobbyists raising money for American elections.

Seven actions to protect American workers:

- ★ **FIRST**, I will announce my intention to renegotiate NAFTA or withdraw from the deal under Article 2205.
- ★ **SECOND**, I will announce our withdrawal from the Trans-Pacific Partnership.
- ★ **THIRD**, I will direct the Secretary of the Treasury to label China a currency manipulator.



★ **FOURTH**, I will direct the Secretary of Commerce and U.S. Trade Representative to identify all foreign trading abuses that unfairly impact American workers and direct them to use every tool under American and international law to end those abuses immediately.

★ **FIFTH**, I will lift the restrictions on the production of \$50 trillion dollars' worth of job-producing American energy reserves, including shale, oil, natural gas and clean coal.

★ **SIXTH**, lift the Obama-Clinton roadblocks and allow vital energy infrastructure projects, like the Keystone Pipeline, to move forward.

★ **SEVENTH**, cancel billions in payments to U.N. climate change programs and use the money to fix America's water and environmental infrastructure.

Five actions to restore security and the constitutional rule of law:

- ★ **FIRST**, cancel every unconstitutional executive action, memorandum and order issued by President Obama.
- ★ **SECOND**, begin the process of selecting a replacement for Justice Scalia from one of the 20 judges on my list, who will uphold and defend the U.S. Constitution.
- ★ **THIRD**, cancel all federal funding to sanctuary cities.
- ★ **FOURTH**, begin removing the more than two million criminal illegal immigrants from the country and cancel visas to foreign countries that won't take them back.
- ★ **FIFTH**, suspend immigration from terror-prone regions where vetting cannot safely occur. All vetting of people coming into our country will be considered "extreme vetting."

- Cancel every constitutional executive action issued by President Obama, e.g. DACA.
 - 18,000 DACA recipients in WA
- Cancel all federal funding to so-called "sanctuary cities."
 - \$85M in federal grants to Seattle
- Remove more than two million criminal unauthorized immigrants and cancel visas to foreign countries that won't take them back.
 - +40,000 growth in unauthorized population in WA, 2009-2014



- Suspend immigration from so-called terror-prone regions.
 - Largest Somali community outside of Minneapolis
 - 2/3 of 3,000 refugees each year are re-settled in Seattle/King County
- Build wall along US-Mexico border and make Mexico pay.
- Zero tolerance for immigrants with criminal records.
- Harsher penalties for overstaying a visa.



- Three anti-immigrant/refugee executive orders in the first month:
 1. Enhancing Public Safety in the Interior of the United States
 2. Border Security and Immigration Enforcement Improvements
 3. Protecting the Nation From Foreign Terrorist Entry Into the United States
- Rescinded DACA.
- Eliminated TPS for Haiti, El Salvador, Nicaragua (Honduras remains).
- Reduced annual refugee cap by more than half (110,000 to 45,000).



What We're Doing

Naturalization

To provide free naturalization services to low-income individuals and families.

- New Citizen Campaign
- New Citizen Program
- Monthly citizenship clinics

Language Access

To ensure residents can get information and access services regardless of the language that they speak.

- City departments develop language access work plans
- Release toolkit and other resources

To provide leadership, systems navigation, and parenting skills for immigrant families that have experienced the juvenile justice system.

- Second year after successful 2017 pilot
- Add parenting skills using Strengthening Families Program curriculum

Ready to Work

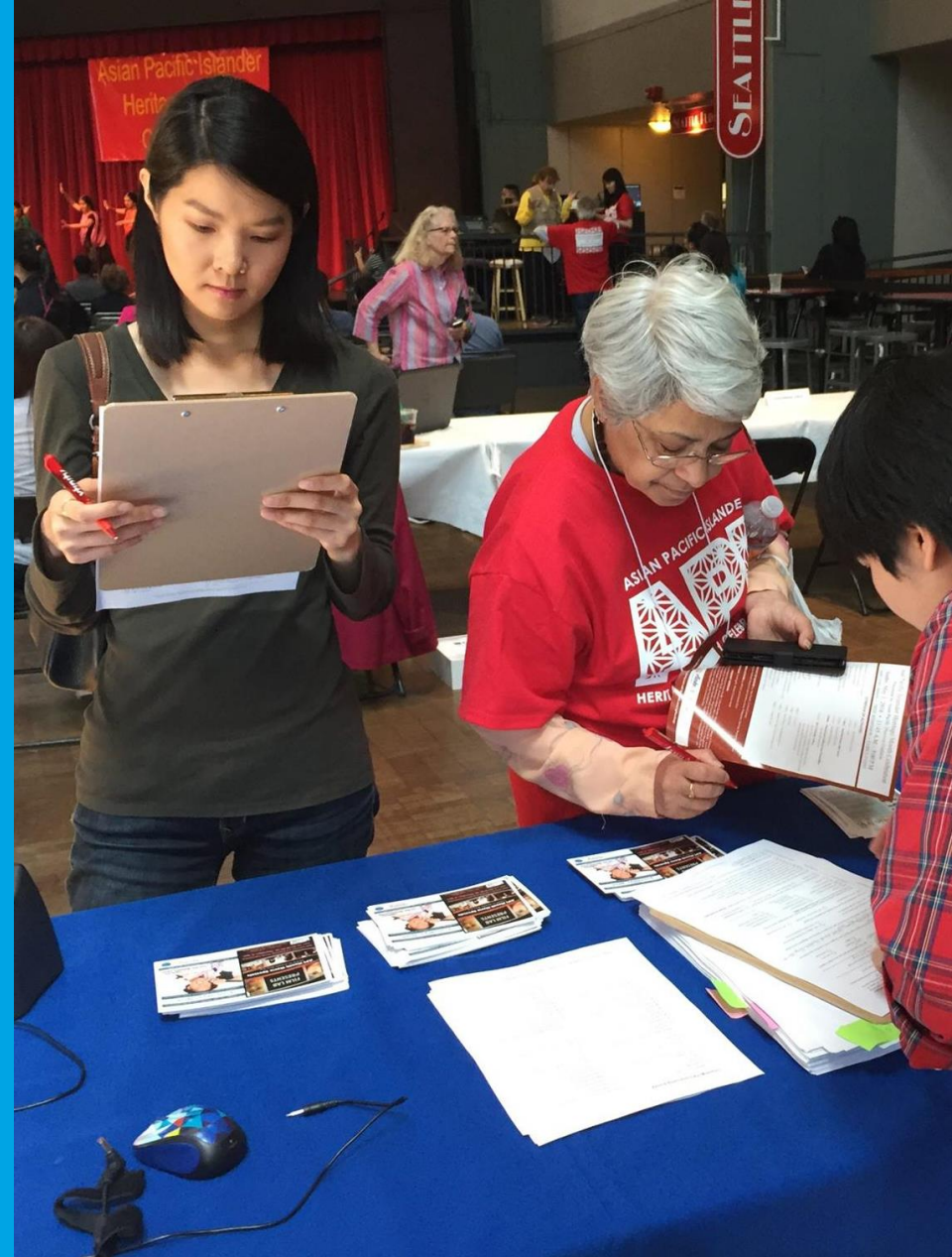
To provide free ESL and job training to low-English proficient adult learners and job seekers.
