DNR Permits: Waterways 3 & 4

Waterway 3 Permit: This agreement allows the City to use Waterway 3, adjacent to Lake Union Park, for Park purposes at no cost. The Property contains open water with a pedestrian bridge and viewing platform.

Waterway 4 Permit: This agreement allows the City to use the upland portion of Waterway 4, adjacent to Lake Union Park, for Park purposes at no cost. The property has been incorporated into the park design and includes gravel, paths, lamp posts and trees.

The open water portion of Waterway 4 is being used by the Center for Wooden Boats under a separate permit.





DNR Permits: Waterways 3 & 4

- The proposed ordinance:
 - Authorizes Seattle Parks to execute and accept from the State of Washington, Department of Natural Resources, (DNR) on behalf of the City of Seattle a Waterway Permit for Waterway 3 and a Waterway Permit for a portion of Waterway 4, both in Lake Union Park.
