Section 2. The Housing Funding Policies for the 2016 Seattle Housing Levy and other fund sources, previously adopted by Ordinance 125308, are amended as shown in Exhibit B to this ordinance.

Section 3. The scope of the Acquisition and Preservation Program as described in Exhibit 1 to Ordinance 125028 is modified to include use of funds for Site Acquisition, as defined in Exhibit B to this ordinance, consistent with the amendments adopted in Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

Section 4. The 2018 Adopted Budget is amended to revise Budget Summary Level Purpose Statements in certain Budget Control Levels for the Office of Housing in Attachment A to Ordinance 125493, which replaced Attachment A to Ordinance 125475, as follows:
