

Amendment 2 to CB 120845 – SPD SIR Real-Time Crime Center ORD

Sponsor: Councilmember Moore

Addressing vendor contracting

Effect: This amendment requests that SPD include certain terms in any contract executed with a third-party vendor for RTCC technology, requires SPD to notify Council of attempts to seek data via request to the vendor, and requires SPD to submit such contract to Council by December 31, 2024.

Add a new Section 2 to CB 120845 as follows and renumber subsequent sections as appropriate:

Section 2. The Council requests that the Seattle Police Department (SPD) include in any contract with a vendor for the implementation of Real-Time Crime Center software technology terms: 1) a requirement that the vendor immediately notify SPD if the vendor receives a warrant or subpoena seeking SPD Real-Time Crime Center data for any purpose, including purposes related to reproductive healthcare or gender-affirming medical services; and 2) a requirement that the vendor retain legal counsel to challenge any such warrant or subpoena and advise of outcome or existence of warrant after expiration. SPD shall notify the Council upon receipt of information related to a vendor warrant or subpoena described in this section. SPD shall provide the Council with a copy of the Real-Time Crime Center software vendor contract once executed but no later than December 31, 2024.
