University of Washington (UW), Montlake Triangle Project

The Montlake Triangle serves as the new grand entrance to the University of Washington campus, safely connecting cyclists and pedestrians to the recently opened UW Light Rail Station by eliminating interaction with vehicular traffic in the area. This award winning project included the lowering of NE Pacific Place by 19 feet and extending the Rainier Vista Plaza into the Montlake Triangle, including the construction of a pedestrian/cyclist landbridge over the lowered roadway. The heavily utilized Burke Gilman Trail was also widened and re-engineered to separate pedestrian and bicycle traffic in all directions, reducing congestion on the trail and increasing ease of travel.

This project involves the replacement of a critical yet aging cornerstone of the regional trails network with a modern, world-class trail facility. The new section meets the needs of existing trail users and provides capacity for future generations of cyclists and pedestrians through improved pedestrian and cyclist safety, enhanced connections to the regional trails network, and increased capacity for growing trail demand. The trail was improved to modern standards through widening and the addition of "mixing zones" at points of confluence with other pathways, bridges, and streets.
