**ORDINANCE** 126414  
COUNCIL BILL 120134

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 125142; granting Swedish Health Services permission to construct, maintain and operate a pedestrian skybridge over and across Minor Avenue, between Columbia Street and Cherry Street; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

WHEREAS, the Seattle City Council passed Ordinance 125142 granting Swedish Health Services permission to construct, maintain and operate a pedestrian skybridge over and across Minor Avenue, between Columbia Street and Cherry Street; and

WHEREAS, Swedish Health Services delayed the construction on the redevelopment of Swedish First Hill Campus and requested an extension to the term of the skybridge permit granted by Ordinance 125142; and

WHEREAS, Swedish Health Services is ready to begin the redevelopment of the Swedish First Hill Campus; NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Sections 2, 14, 17, 19, and 21 of Ordinance 125142 are amended as follows:

\* \* \*

Section 2. **Term.** The permission granted to Permittee is for a term of ~~((ten))~~ 15 years starting on the effective date of this ordinance and ending at 11:59 p.m. on the last day of the ~~((tenth))~~ fifteenth year. Upon written application made by the Permittee at least ~~((180 days))~~ one year before expiration of the term, the Director or the City Council may renew the permit ~~((twice, each time))~~ once for a successive ~~((ten))~~ 15-year term, subject to the right of the City to require the removal of the pedestrian skybridge or to revise by ordinance any of the terms and conditions of the permission granted by this ordinance.

1 The total term of the permission, including renewals, shall not exceed 30 years. The  
2 Permittee shall submit any application for a new permission no later than ~~((180 days))~~  
3 one year prior to the expiration of the then-existing term.

5 Section 14. **Consent for and conditions of assignment or transfer.** ~~((The~~  
6 ~~permission granted by this ordinance shall not be assignable or transferable by operation~~  
7 ~~of law; nor shall))~~ When the Property is transferred, the permission granted by this  
8 ordinance shall be assignable and transferable by operation of law pursuant to Section 20  
9 of this ordinance. Continued occupation of the right-of-way constitutes the Permittee's  
10 acceptance of the terms of this ordinance, and the new owner shall be conferred with the  
11 rights and obligations of the Permittee by this ordinance. Other than a transfer to a new  
12 owner the Permittee shall not transfer, assign, mortgage, pledge or encumber the same  
13 without the Director's consent, which the Director shall not unreasonably refuse. The  
14 Director may approve assignment or transfer of the permission granted by this ordinance  
15 to a successor entity only if the successor or assignee has ~~((accepted in writing all of the~~  
16 ~~terms and conditions of the permission granted by this ordinance; has provided, at the~~  
17 ~~time of the acceptance,))~~ provided the bond and certification of insurance coverage  
18 required under this ordinance; and has paid any fees due under Section 15 and Section 17  
19 of this ordinance. Upon the Director's approval of an assignment or transfer, the rights  
20 and obligations conferred on the Permittee by this ordinance shall be conferred on the  
21 successors and assigns. Any person or entity seeking approval for an assignment or  
22 transfer of the permission granted by this ordinance shall provide the Director with a  
23 description of the current and anticipated use of the pedestrian skybridge.

2           Section 17. **Annual fee.** Beginning on the effective date of this ordinance, and  
3 annually thereafter, the Permittee shall promptly pay to the City, upon statements or  
4 invoices issued by the Director, an ~~((annual fee))~~ Annual Renewal Fee, and an Annual  
5 Use and Occupation Fee of ~~(((\$13,474.93))~~ \$27,059.93 or as adjusted annually thereafter,  
6 for the privileges granted by this ordinance.

7           Adjustments to the ~~((annual fee))~~ Annual Use and Occupation Fee shall be made  
8 in accordance with a term permit fee schedule adopted by the City Council and may be  
9 made every year. In the absence of a schedule, the Director may only increase or  
10 decrease the previous year's fee to reflect any inflationary changes so as to charge the  
11 fee in constant dollar terms. This adjustment will be calculated by adjusting the previous  
12 year's fee by the percentage change between the two most recent year-end values  
13 available for the Consumer Price Index for the Seattle-Tacoma-~~((Bremerton))~~ Bellevue  
14 Area, All Urban Consumers, All Products, Not Seasonally Adjusted. All payments shall  
15 be made to the City Finance Director for credit to the Transportation ~~((Operating))~~ Fund.

17           Section 19. **Acceptance of terms and conditions.** The Permittee shall ~~((deliver to~~  
18 ~~the Director its written signed acceptance of the terms of this ordinance))~~ provide  
19 evidence of insurance coverage required by Section 10 of this ordinance, the bond as  
20 required by Section 12 of this ordinance, and the covenant agreement required by Section  
21 20 of this ordinance within 60 days after the effective date of this ordinance. ~~((The~~  
22 ~~Director shall file the written acceptance with the City Clerk. If no such acceptance is~~  
23 ~~received within that 60-day period, the privileges conferred by this ordinance shall be~~

1 ~~deemed declined or abandoned and the permission granted deemed lapsed and forfeited.))~~

2 The Permittee shall not commence construction of the skybridge prior to the Permittee  
3 delivering ~~((its written signed acceptance of the terms of this ordinance and providing))~~  
4 the bond and certificate of insurance coverage required by this ordinance as well as the  
5 covenant agreement required by Section 20 of this ordinance. Obtaining building permits  
6 from the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections, and other applicable City-  
7 issued permits, constitutes the Permittee's acceptance of the terms of this ordinance.

9 Section 21. **Public benefit mitigation.** Permittee shall construct the following  
10 public benefit mitigation within one year of the ~~((effective date of this ordinance))~~  
11 issuance of certificate of occupancy for Block 95:

12 a) A 3,200-square-foot garden located at the intersection of Minor Avenue  
13 and Columbia Street;

14 b) Curated outdoor art located in the garden at the intersection of Minor  
15 Avenue and Columbia Street;

16 c) Artwork element consistent with the final recommendation of the  
17 Swedish Public Art Advisory Committee on the pedestrian skybridge that is visible from  
18 the street;

19 d) Intersection and sidewalk improvements at Minor Avenue and  
20 Columbia Street, including a partially raised intersection, ADA accessible ramps, and  
21 crosswalk striping, to enhance the pedestrian environment; and

22 e) Expanded pedestrian streetscape, including street paving, curb,  
23 sidewalk and curb ramps, street trees, plantings, and pedestrian lighting on the

1 east side of Minor Avenue directly in front of the existing emergency department.

2 Implementation of the art public benefit features requires review of the Swedish

3 Public Art Advisory Committee that includes members from the Seattle Design


4 Commission.

5 Section 2. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken prior to its

6 effective date is ratified and confirmed.


1 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by  
2 the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it  
3 shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
