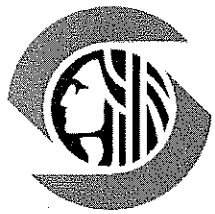


I am pleased to appoint you to the Housing Levy Oversight Committee. You will be serving a term ending December 31, 2016.
