Amendment 5, Version 1a to CB 120309 – IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software

**Sponsor:** Councilmember Strauss

*Independent Risk Evaluation*

**Effect:** Requests that the Executive include funding in the mid-year 2022 Supplemental Budget for the Office of Inspector General to retain a consultant to evaluate and report on the civil liberties risks associated with the Seattle Police Department’s use of IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software by March 31, 2023. The report should include the accuracy of the data manually input into IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software, the accuracy of linkages identified by users of IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software, and demographic information about the individuals and groups associated with each IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software visualization.

Insert a new Section after Section 1 of Council Bill 120309 as follows and renumber subsequent sections as appropriate:

Section X. The Council requests the Executive to include funding in the mid-year 2022 Supplemental Budget for the Office of Inspector General for Public Safety to retain a consultant to conduct an evaluation of the civil liberties risks associated with the Seattle Police Department’s use of IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software, including the accuracy of the data manually input into IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software, the accuracy of linkages identified by users of IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software, and demographic information about the individuals and groups associated with each IBM i2 iBase Link Analysis Software visualization. Findings from the evaluation should be filed with the Clerk by March 31, 2023.
