The Seattle City Council's Select Budget Committee, chaired by Councilmember Mosqueda, will conduct a remote public hearing on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, to solicit public comment on the following: (1) the City's 2021 General Revenue Sources, including a possible property tax levy increase; and (2) the Mayor's 2021 Proposed Budget and 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program.

The hearing begins at 5:30 p.m. and will continue until all those remotely present to provide public comment have participated.
