Effective date delay

**Effect:** This amendment would delay the effective date of the restrictions on the use of fossil fuels and electric resistance for water heating in new commercial buildings to April 1, 2022. This would allow the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections additional time to conduct outreach regarding the change prior to the restriction going into effect.

Amend Section 8 and add a new Section 9 to Council Bill 120239, as follows:

Section 8. Sections 1 through 7 of this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on April 1, 2022.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
