Resolution Purpose



North Rainier Site Plan

RCO administers a competitive State of Washington grant process and requires formal approval of grant applications authorizing the agency to apply for grants.

- The proposed Resolution authorizes SPR to apply for \$8,800,000 in funding for 5 projects (detailed on subsequent slides)
- This cycle, the Resolution must be delivered to RCO by August 31, 2022



Project Selection Process



Little Brook Park Conceptual Design

Projects funded with RCO grant dollars must be operated and maintained in perpetuity for the purposes for which funding is sought.

SPR staff select project applications based on multiple factors including:

- Availability of matching funds
- Ability to meet above RCO requirement
- Location in an Equity Zone
- Fit within grant program requirements
- Has community support
- Ability to meet grant timelines
- Conceptional design in place
- Inclusion in an SPR planning study
- Urgency to replace/repair

1590 NW 90th St, Seattle, WA 98117 - Council District #6


- Multi-sport all season synthetic turf athletic fields
