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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Designation. Under Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.12.660, the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board") of the improvement located at 7201 Beacon Avenue S and the site on which the improvement is located (which are collectively referred to as the "Original Van Asselt School") is acknowledged. A. Legal Description. The Original Van Asselt School is located on the property legally

described as:

THAT PORTION OF LOT 43, PLAT OF SOMERVILLE FILED ON JANUARY 24TH, 1887 IN VOLUME 2, PAGE 63 OF PLATS, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS; BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SOUTHEAST MARGIN OF BEACON AVENUE, SAID MARGIN BEING 63' SOUTHWEST AND PARALLEL WITH IT'S CENTERLINE ACCORDING TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE ORDINANCE NUMBER 30071, AND THE CENTERLINE OF VACATED SHAFFER AVENUE SOUTH ACCORDING TO SURVEY FILED UNDER RECORDER'S NUMBER 20030814900008, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON. THENCE SOUTH 0°33'57" WEST ALONG SAID CENTERLINE, A DISTANCE OF 196.70 FEET TO THE NORTH LINE OF THE PLAT OF DUWAMISH HEIGHTS AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 15 OF PLATS, PAGE 96, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, THENCE NORTH 87°30'12" WEST ALONG SAID NORTH LINE, A DISTANCE 530.53 FEET TO A POINT ON EAST MARGIN OF VACATED PERKINS AVENUE; THENCE NORTH 0°39'12" EAST ALONG SAID EAST MARGIN, 289.63 FEET TO IT'S INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTH MARGIN OF VACATED SOUTH ORCHARD STREET; THENCE SOUTH 87°24'16" EAST ALONG SAID SOUTH MARGIN, 419.37 FEET TO SAID SOUTHEAST MARGIN OF BEACON AVENUE, THENCE SOUTH 44°30'17" EAST ALONG SAID SOUTHEAST MARGIN, A DISTANCE OF 135.15 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. SITUATED IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

- B. Specific Features or Characteristics Designated. Under SMC 25.12.660.A.2, the Board designated the following specific features or characteristics of the Original Van Asselt School:
 - 1. The site as illustrated in Attachment A to this ordinance.
 - 2. The exterior of the 1909 building (excluding the 1940 and 2002 rear additions).
 - 3. The interior of the 1909 building (excluding the 1940 and 2002 rear additions).

1	1) Significant to the property's history or design, as outlined in the
2	nomination application.
3	2) A designated Heritage Tree on the City of Seattle/Plant

6	d. Planting of new trees in locations that will never obscure the view of
7	designated features of the landmark, or physically undermine a built feature of the landmark.
8	e. Planting or removal of shrubs, perennials, or annuals, in locations that
9	will never obscure the view of designated features of the landmark, or physically undermine a
10	built feature of the landmark.
11	f. Installation, removal, or alteration of the following site furnishings:
12	benches, chairs, tables, swings, movable planters, and trash/recycling receptacles, and bike racks.
13	g. Installation, removal, or alteration (including repair) of underground
14	irrigation and underground utilities, provided that the site is restored in kind.
15	h. Repaving and restriping of existing asphalt paved areas.
16	i. Installation, removal, or alteration of play equipment in existing outdoor
17	play areas.
18	j. Installation, removal, or alteration of signage for accessibility
19	compliance, school safety, and other signage as required by City code or Seattle Public Schools
20	safety signage for playgrounds; e.g., "No Guns" or "No Trespassing."
21	k. Installation, removal, or alteration of a building identification sign
22	defined by the following criteria:
23	1) The sign shall be freestanding on the site.



1	2) The sign shall not be attached to built historic features.
2	3) The sign location shall not obscure the view of designated
3	features of the buildings or site.
4	4) The sign's content may include the building name, street
5	address, and logo associated with the school's identity.
6	5) The sign shall not be internally illuminated.
7	6) The sign shall be no more than 30 square feet in area, and the
8	top of the sign shall not exceed 4 feet above grade.
9	l. Removal of portable classroom buildings.
10	m. Installation of new single-story portable classrooms or a storage shed,
11	when located within the area illustrated in Attachment B to this ordinance.
12	n. Installation or removal of interior, temporary window shading devices
13	that are operable and do not obscure the glazing when in the open position.
14	o. Installation, removal, or alteration of curbs, bollards, or wheelstops in
15	parking areas.
16	p. Installation or removal of artwork located at the building interior, when
17	fastened to gypsum wallboard surfaces.
18	q. Installation, removal, or alteration of the playfield surface, track
19	materials, field lights, field drainage, ground source wells, and other track/field equipment.
20	r. Demolition of the 1950 building.
21	s. Alterations or changes to the portion of the 1950s building located on
22	the designated site, provided they do not increase the footprint or height of the building.

1	l. Alterations to interior features or characteristics of the landmark that
2	were designated by the Board for preservation.
3	m. Installation of photovoltaic panels.
4	n. Changes to paint colors for any of the features or characteristics of the
5	landmark that were designated by the Board for preservation.
6	o. Replacement of non-historic doors and windows within original
7	openings, when the staff determines that the design intent is consistent with the Secretary of the
8	Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation.
9	p. Alterations or changes to the portion of the 1950s building located on
10	the designated site, when the footprint or height of the building is proposed to be increased, and
11	the project does not qualify for review by the Landmarks staff under the State Environmental
12	Policy Act (SEPA).
13	q. Emergency repairs or measures (including immediate action to secure
14	the area, install temporary equipment, and employ stabilization methods as necessary to protect
15	the public's safety, health, and welfare) to address hazardous conditions with adverse impacts to
16	the buildings or site as related to a seismic or other unforeseen event. Following such an
17	emergency, the owner shall adhere to the following:
18	1) The owner shall immediately notify the City Historic
19	Preservation Officer and document the conditions and actions the owner took.
20	2) If temporary structural supports are necessary, the owner shall
21	make all reasonable efforts to prevent further damage to historic resources.
22	3) The owner shall not remove historic building materials from the
23	site as part of the emergency response.

1	4) In consultation with the City Historic Preservation Officer and
2	staff, the owner shall adopt and implement a long-term plan to address any damage through
3	appropriate solutions.
4	Section 3. Incentives. The following incentives are granted on the features or
5	characteristics of the Original Van Asselt School that were designated by the Board for
6	preservation:
7	A. Uses not otherwise permitted in a zone may be authorized in a designated landmark by
8	means of an administrative conditional use permit issued under SMC Title 23.
9	B. Exceptions to certain of the requirements of the Seattle Building Code and the Seattle
10	Energy Code, adopted by SMC Chapter 22.101, may be authorized according to the applicable
11	provisions.
12	C. Special tax valuation for historic preservation may be available under chapter 84.26
13	RCW upon application and compliance with the requirements of that statute.
14	D. Reduction or waiver, under certain conditions, of minimum accessory off-street
15	parking requirements for uses permitted in a designated landmark structure may be permitted
16	under SMC Title 23.
17	Section 4. Enforcement of this ordinance and penalties for its violation are as provided in
18	SMC 25.12.910.
19	Section 5. The Original Van Asselt School is added alphabetically to Section IV, Schools,
20	of the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32.

4	to provide a certified copy of this ordinance to the Original Van Asselt School's owner.
