








Domestic Violence

Criminal Traffic



Filed Cases vs Declined Cases





Close-in-Time Filing




Decline Rate

(by year report was received)






Backlog of Cases Awaiting Review

Unable to Prove Beyond Reasonable Doubt Doubt Contact Victim


