1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: relating to incentivizing regional partners to develop homeless shelter; lifting a budget proviso imposed on Finance General's Reserves Budget Control Level; changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; making cash transfers between various City funds; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

Summary and background of the Legislation: This legislation lifts the proviso on the \$175,000 that the City Council added with Green Sheet 61-1-B-1 in the 2015 Adopted Budget to incentivize regional partners to develop homeless shelter. The legislation transfers budget authority from Finance General to the Human Services Department, and authorizes a cash transfer.

This legislation allows the Department to achieve results for the most vulnerable citizens, including those impacted by homelessness/housing instability; the data shows that people of color are disproportionately represented in services for the homeless.
