- The working farm will provide educational, gardening, and food resource opportunities in Southeast Seattle.

## The Funding:

- The project was awarded \$500,000 from the Opportunity Fund of the 2008 Parks & Green Spaces Levy.
- A partnership between Seattle Parks Foundation, Friends of Rainier Beach Urban Farm and Wetlands, and Seattle Tilth was established to complete substantial fundraising.
- This legislation creates appropriation authority to accept the donated funds.



## The Appropriation:

Seattle Park Foundation: \$1,221,050

Friends of Rainier Beach

Urban Farm & Wetlands: \$316,000

Seattle Tilth: \$307,790
