- \$118,460 from the Seattle Chamber of Commerce for HSD to provide approximately 35 youth and young adult internships through the Youth Employment Initiative; and
- \$114,466 from the United States Department of Homeland Security for the Seattle Police Department to purchase personal preparedness equipment and specialized SWAT equipment and \$67,500 in funding for structural shoring equipment and Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosives (CBRNE) Class 2 suits.

Expenditure authority to use these grant funds is provided in C.B. 118530, the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2015 supplemental budget ordinance.
