Notice of Seattle City Council Final Action to Adopt an Ordinance Authorizing Condemnation (Eminent Domain) of real property located at 4500 West Marginal Way SW, Seattle, WA 98106 (King County Tax Parcel 7666703680) in the City of Seattle, Washington

Dear Mr. Rexroth:

The purpose of this Notice is to inform you that the City of Seattle City Council is expected to vote on an ordinance, which, if approved, will authorize the acquisition of your real property located at 4500 West Marginal Way SW in the City of Seattle, Washington. A copy of the proposed ordinance and a map depicting the project location are enclosed for your information.

This ordinance, if adopted, will contain authorization for the City to acquire your property through negotiation or, if necessary, condemnation, as part of the Seattle Public Utilities' Drainage & Wastewater Operations Complex Project.

You are identified by the tax rolls of King County as an owner of property of record whose property may be affected by this legislation. The City is required by RCW 8.25.290 to provide each property owner of record for each property potentially affected by the ordinance with formal written notice 15 days before the City takes final action authorizing condemnation of property. The time, date, and place of the final action on the ordinance are described below.

The City will take public comment and discuss the ordinance at the Seattle City Council Seattle Public Utilities and Neighborhoods Committee as a regular part of the committee meeting beginning at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 19, 2015, in the City Council Chambers, located at 600 4th Avenue, 2nd Floor, Seattle, WA 98104.
