1 CITY OF SEATTLE ORDINANCE 124934 2 COUNCIL BILL 118448 3 4 AN ORDINANCE relating to historic preservation; imposing controls upon the Schoenfeld 5 Building, a landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Board under Chapter 6 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal Code, and adding it to the Table of Historical Landmarks 7 contained in Chapter 25.32 of the Seattle Municipal Code. 8 9 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal 10 Code (SMC), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of sites, 11 improvements, and objects having historical, cultural, architectural, engineering, or 12 geographic significance; and 13 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board (Board), after a public meeting on October 15, 14 2014, voted to approve the nomination of the improvement located at 1012 First Avenue 15 (which is referred to as the "Schoenfeld Building" for the purposes of this ordinance) for 16 designation as a landmark under SMC Chapter 25.12; and 17 WHEREAS, after a public meeting on November 19, 2014, the Board voted to approve the 18 designation of the Schoenfeld Building under SMC Chapter 25.12; and 19 WHEREAS, on February 4, 2015, the Board and the owner of the designated landmark agreed to 20 controls and incentives; and 21 WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council enact a designating ordinance 22 approving the controls and incentives; NOW, THEREFORE, 23 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: 24 Section 1. <u>DESIGNATION</u>: Pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.12.660, the 25 designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board (Board) of the improvement located at 1012 26

| 9 | B. <u>Specific Features or Characteristics Designated</u> . Pursuant to SMC 25.12.660.A.2, |
| 10. | the following specific features or characteristics of the Schoenfeld Building are designated: the |

| 12 | C. <u>Basis of Designation</u> . The designation was made because the Schoenfeld Building |
| 13 | is more than 25 years old, has significant character, interest or value as a part of the |
| 14 | development, heritage or cultural characteristics of the City, state or nation, has integrity or the |
| 15 | ability to convey its significance, and satisfies the following from SMC 25.12.350: |
| 16 | 1. It is associated in a significant way with the life of a person important in the |
| 17 | history of the City, state, or nation (SMC 25.12.350.B). |
| 18 | 2. It is associated in a significant way with a significant aspect of the cultural, |
| 19 | political, or economic heritage of the community, City, state or nation (SMC |
| 20 | 25.12.350.C). |
| 21 | 3. It embodies the distinctive visible characteristics of an architectural style, period, |
| 22 | or a method of construction (SMC 25.12.350.D). |
| 23 | Section 2. <u>CONTROLS</u> : The following controls are hereby imposed on the features or |
| 24 | characteristics of the Schoenfeld Building that were designated by the Board for preservation: |

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Certificate of Approval Process. A.

- 1. Except as provided in subsection 2.A.2 or subsection 2.B, the owner must obtain a Certificate of Approval issued by the Board pursuant to SMC Chapter 25.12, or the time for denying a Certificate of Approval must have expired, before the owner may make alterations or significant changes to the following specific features or characteristics: the exterior of the building.
- 2. No Certificate of Approval is required for the following: any in-kind maintenance or repairs of the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.A.1.
- City Historic Preservation Officer Approval Process. В.
 - 1. The City Historic Preservation Officer (CHPO) may review and approve alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.B.3 according to the following procedure:
 - The owner shall submit to the CHPO a written request for the alterations or significant changes, including applicable drawings or specifications.
 - b. If the CHPO, upon examination of submitted plans and specifications, determines that the alterations or significant changes are consistent with the purposes of SMC Chapter 25.12, the CHPO shall approve the alterations or significant changes without further action by the Board.
 - c. If the CHPO does not approve the alterations or significant changes, the owner may submit revised materials to the CHPO, or apply to the Board for a Certificate of Approval under SMC Chapter 25.12.

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- 2. The CHPO shall transmit a written decision on the owner's request to the owner within 14 days of receipt of the request. Failure of the CHPO to timely transmit a written decision constitutes approval of the request.
- 3. CHPO approval of alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.A.1 is available for the following:
 - The installation, alteration or removal of duct conduits, HVAC vents, grilles, fire escapes, pipes, meters and utility connections, downspouts and gutters and other similar wiring or mechanical elements necessary for the normal operation of the building.
 - b. The installation, alteration, or removal of exterior security lighting, video cameras, and security system equipment.
 - The installation, alteration, or removal of signage.
 - d. Alterations to the alley elevation.
- Section 3. <u>INCENTIVES</u>: The following incentives are hereby granted on the features or characteristics of the Schoenfeld Building that were designated by the Board for preservation:
- Uses not otherwise permitted in a zone may be authorized in a designated A. landmark by means of an administrative conditional use permit issued pursuant to SMC Title 23.
- Special tax valuation for historic preservation may be available under RCW В. Chapter 84.26 upon application and compliance with the requirements of that statute.
- Exceptions to certain requirements of the Seattle Building Code, SMC Chapter C. 22.100, and the Seattle Energy Code, SMC Chapter 22.700, may be authorized pursuant to the applicable provisions thereof.

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The Owner may be eligible to participate in the City's Landmark Transfer of D. Development Rights (TDR) Bank after obtaining a determination from the City concerning the quantity of unused development rights for the Landmark that are eligible for transfer to receiving properties as Landmark TDR, pursuant to SMC 23.49.014.

Section 4. Enforcement of this ordinance and penalties for its violation are as provided in SMC 25.12.910.

Section 5. The Schoenfeld Building is hereby added alphabetically to Section II, Buildings, of the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32.

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Director of Records and Elections, deliver two certified copies to the CHPO, and deliver one copy to the Director of the Department of Planning and Development. The CHPO is directed to provide a certified copy of the ordinance to the owner of the landmark.
