AN ORDINANCE relating to homelessness; lifting a budget proviso imposed on Finance General's Reserves Budget Control Level; and making cash transfers between various City funds.

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Section 3. As part of amendments to the 2016 Budget included in what is commonly known as the 2016 First Quarter Supplemental Budget Ordinance, the City Council intends to increase appropriations by up to \$200,000 solely to remedy conditions directly associated with unsanctioned camping in Seattle that may pose significant threats to health and safety of people living in or adjacent to unsanctioned camps and may be spent for no other purpose. Such conditions include but are not limited to lack of running water or basic sanitation and lack of facilities for disposing of garbage, recycling, and compost. Remedies may include but are not limited to hand-washing stations; portable toilets and showers; containers for disposing of used needles with collection service; and containers for sorting and disposing of trash, recycling, and compost with collection service. This appropriation may not be used for encampment removals.

Section 34. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

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
