### **1. BILL SUMMARY**

**Legislation Title:** AN ORDINANCE related to the operation of tour and excursion vehicles; creating a new Chapter 15.66 in the Seattle Municipal Code.

**Summary and background of the Legislation:** If passed, this legislation would prohibit tour vehicle operators from narrating tours while the vehicle is in motion on a public street, road or highway.

Tour companies in Seattle operate tour vehicles, charter party vehicles, and excursion service vehicles. Some tour companies have a single employee who both drives the vehicle and narrates the tour. This may create safety concerns because driving a tour bus is complex and providing tour narration could distract the driver.
