

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT 4**  
**Council Bill 118656: 2016 Housing Levy**

Amendment Name: Homelessness Prevention Program

Brief Description: This amendment would modify the title of the Homelessness Prevention Program to add “and Housing Stability Services.” In addition, the program description adds the word “address.” These changes provide flexibility to fund programs, such as Rapid Rehousing, the Landlord Liaison project, and other programs serving people experiencing homelessness or those at risk of homelessness. These and other programs may be included in the Homeless Investment Policy report that will be submitted to Council in early summer.

1. Modify the “Homelessness Prevention” row in Exhibit 1 as follows (title row shown for reference purposes):
