This project increases the capacity of City Light's power distribution systems, to serve projected light rail traffic increases. Initial upgrades will be in the Capitol Hill Sound Transit Station area, where there are critical system constraints. Construction will be underway in 2017. Other areas projected to need power distribution system upgrades include the Sound Transit East Link line area between the International District Station & Lake Washington, the University of Washington Station area, areas in the Rainier valley near the MLK section of the Initial Link line, as well as some areas along the proposed Lynnwood Link line. This project will coordinate with the existing Sound Transit projects, 8450, Sound Transit Light Rail East Link – City Light, 8471, Sound Transit Lynnwood - City Light, and 8427, Sound Transit Northlink - City Light. Work under this project will be fully reimbursable.
