


SF Office of Labor Standards Enforcement Overview

- OLSE Director → appointed by Mayor
- OLSE enforces **local labor laws** adopted by SF voters & the SF Board of Supervisors.
- OLSE Laws
 - city-wide
 - specific to entities doing business with SF (contractors, lessees)

Predictable Scheduling & Fair Treatment (33G)



Covered Employers.

- Formula Retail Establishments (FREs), SF Planning Code
- ("Brick & Mortar") | Property Service Contractors
- 40+ Locations Worldwide
- 20+ Employees in SF



Offering Additional Hours to Existing Part-Time EEs.

- "Qualified" > "Reasonably Determined" by ER
- Additional Work → "Same or Similar"
- Up to 35 Hours/No Overtime Requirement
- Four Hour Rule



Employee Retention (Change in Control).

- 90 Day Retention Policy (6 Month+ EEs)
- Notice Requirements
 - Post
 - Provide to EEs



Formula Retail Employee Rights Ordinances (FREROs)

Predictable Scheduling & Fair Treatment

Advance Notice of Schedule.

- 14-Day Advance Notice of Schedule
- New EEs

 Good Faith Written Estimate

 Minimum Number of Scheduled Shifts

 Days/Hours of Shifts



Predictability Pay for Schedule Changes.

- Employer-Required Schedule Changes | Regular Hourly Rate
- < 7 Days' Notice: 1 Hour | < 24 Hrs: 2 to 4 Hours
- "Required" \(\rightarrow\) "Pressure or Coerce"
- Exceptions \rightarrow EE-requested Schedule Changes



Equal Treatment for Part-Time/Full-Time EEs.

- Same "starting hourly wage" > Equal Skill/Responsibility
- Same Access to Paid/Unpaid Time Off
- Promotion Eligibility
