11	WHEREAS, in May 1979 the City acquired the vacant property located at 10610 55th Ave. S. in
12	fee simple by a Local Improvement Assessment Deed as payment in full for a delinquent
13	local improvement assessment; and
14	WHEREAS, the Department of Finance and Administrative Services (FAS) has determined that
15	the property does not serve an essential City function; and
16	WHEREAS, by Resolution 30862, the City adopted amended Procedures for the Evaluation of
17	the Reuse and Disposal of the City's Real Property, which established a uniform
18	evaluation process for the reuse or disposal of real property the City owns in fee simple;
