<b>Background:</b> Anders McConachie is a queer/trans/FTM who is an enthusiastic advocate for the LGBTQIA community. His advocacy began in his childhood in the South where with the help of GLSEN he was a co-founder of the first GSA in his school district. While in high school he lobbied for the protection of LGBTQ students at the state capitol. He continued his advocacy in University where he was the vice-president of the GSA and worked to create a safe and welcoming place for queer youth and university students. Anders graduated with a BA in Digital Art with a focus in Sound from Stetson University in December of 2007. He moved to Seattle in the summer of 2008 where he has continued to be active with the community and looking more specifically at intersectional issues and the under-served parts of the population. In his professional career he has worked primarily with non-profits with a focus on food justice and education access, while in his free time he is active with a core group of individuals in the creation of ECHO (Equality Coalition for Housing and Opportunity), which recently hosted its first event on Transgender Homelessness in King County at City Hall. He also is a volunteer for the Pride Foundation and Three Dollar Bill Cinema. Anders' goals for the commission include contribution to the policy and accountability for the rights and needs of the LGBTQIA community, especially the youth, elders, low-income, people of color, under housed, and underemployed.
