

Westlake Park and Occidental Square DSA Activation Agreement

Agreement Background

- Under a Pilot Agreement, launched May 2015, the Downtown Seattle Association (DSA) has been managing activation of Westlake Park and Occidental Square
- The agreement is with DSA's management subsidiary:
 DBIA Services
- New amenities: furniture, ping pong, foosball, reading rooms, enhanced plantings





- Programs and events: yoga classes, buskers, ping pong tournaments, kids activities, etc.
- 24/7 staffing: daily ambassadors, nighttime security





Pilot Agreement Outcomes--2015

- Ratio of private dollars to SPR dollars = \$9.25:\$1
- Westlake, July 2015 -- 31% increase in park visitors versus same period the previous year.
- Female: Male Ratio Average
 - Westlake June-December -- 1:1.3
 - Occidental July-December -- 1: 2.15
- Park Surveys
 - 0 82% felt safe
 - o 95% plan to return







• Following a formal RFP review process, DSA was identified as the partner with which to enter into a 5-year agreement for activation of these same parks

The City will:

- Provide \$900,000 over the 5-year term of the agreement
 - Funding is from the Park District's Urban Parks
 Partnership Initiative
- Complete a capital projects prioritization assessment of Westlake Park
- Permit and manage First
 Amendment and free speech activities



DSA will:

 Match the City's \$900,000 contribution at a minimum of 3 private dollars for every 1 City dollar.

 Manage permitting and scheduling of activation, programming, concessions, vending and special

events

 Track and report to SPR attendance and financial data
