## 1. BILL SUMMARY

**Legislation Title:** AN ORDINANCE relating to City responses to people who are homeless living on public property; setting standards and procedures for remedying unsafe conditions and protecting the rights and property of homeless individuals.

## Summary and background of the Legislation:

This bill would change how the City of Seattle responds to unauthorized camping in areas owned, leased, maintained, controlled or managed by a government of public entity. In general, it would designate the Customer Service Bureau as the coordinating entity; set a threshold for investigation; direct provision of services upon request; set conditions for removal and impoundment of personal possessions and vehicles, including timing, outreach, notice, and documentation; specify standards for storing impounded items and for their retrieval; establish a Implementation and Advisory Committee; and establish penalties to be paid by the City for the failure to follow the requirements.
