Budget Action description:

This green sheet recommends passage of C.B. xxx to implement a new \$25 per FTE Employee Hours Tax (EHT). The tax would be similar to the Bridging the Gap Employee Hours Tax that was in place from 2006-2009, but would eliminate exemptions and reporting requirements that proved problematic to administer.

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Assuming a six month lag in implementation, the tax would generate approximately \$5 million in 2017, and \$10 million/year in the following years. Revenue from this tax could fund any general fund purposes.

FAS administrative costs are estimated at 2 IT System Support and 2 Tax Processing and Customer Support Staff, plus \$50,000 for non-labor administrative costs. This green sheet provides funding for 10 months of staff expenses in anticipation of hiring delay. FAS may need to divert staff resources and backfill to achieve a July 2017 implementation date.
