CITY OF SEATTLE 1 ORDINANCE 125305 2 COUNCIL BILL 118847 3 4 AN ORDINANCE conditioning the Seattle Department of Transportation's 2017 grant 5 applications, and repealing Ordinance 118719. 6 7 WHEREAS, the Seattle Department of Transportation applies for a variety of state, federal, and 8 other external funding grants to construct the transportation projects identified in the 9 City's Capital Improvement Plan; and 10 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to affirm support for large capital projects in advance of 11 the Seattle Department of Transportation applying for external grants; and 12 WHEREAS, this ordinance does not direct or require that the Seattle Department of 13 Transportation apply for specific grants; and 14 WHEREAS, this ordinance may be amended during 2017 to reflect emerging funding 15 opportunities or capital priorities; NOW, THEREFORE, 16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: 17 Section 1. Ordinance 118719, authorizing the Mayor or Mayor's designee to enter into 18 grant agreements and accept grant funds from various local, state, and federal sources for 19 projects identified in the adopted Transportation Capital Improvement Program (TCIP), passed 20 by the City Council on September 15, 1997, and signed by the Mayor on September 18, 1997, is 21 repealed in its entirety. 22 Section 2. In 2017, the Seattle Department of Transportation is prohibited from applying 23 for project grants of \$5,000,000 or more of external funding, unless authorized in Section 3 of 24 this ordinance. This prohibition applies only to competitive grant programs. 25
